## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1222

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 4 Section 89-12-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 5 amended as follows:
- 89-12-3. As used in this act, unless the context otherwise 6
- 7 requires:
- "Banking organization" means any national or state 8 (a)
- 9 bank, trust company, savings bank, land bank, private banker, or
- 10 any similar organization which is engaged in business in this
- 11 state.
- 12 (b) "Business association" means any corporation, joint
- 13 stock company, business trust, partnership, or any association for
- 14 business purposes of two (2) or more individuals, whether
- 15 organized for profit or nonprofit, including, but not limited to,
- 16 a banking organization, financial organization, life insurance
- 17 corporation and utility.
- 18 "Financial organization" means any federal or state
- 19 savings and loan association, building and loan association,
- credit union, cooperative bank or investment company, or any 20
- 21 similar organization which is engaged in business in this state.
- "Holder" means any person in possession of property 22
- 23 subject to the provisions of this act belonging to another, or who
- 24 is trustee in case of a trust, or is indebted to another on an
- 25 obligation subject to the provisions of this chapter.
- 26 "Insurance corporation" means any association or (e)
- 27 corporation transacting in this state the business of insurance
- involving in any manner a person or property; however, this term 28
- does not include self-insured workers' compensation groups or 29

- 30 associations comprised of members who have joint and several
- liability for the workers' compensation obligation of the other 31
- 32 members.
- 33 (f) "Intangible personal property" includes, but is not
- 34 limited to:
- 35 (i) Monies, checks, drafts, deposits, interest,
- dividends, and income; 36
- 37 (ii) Credit balances, customer overpayments, gift
- 38 certificates, security deposits, refunds, credit memos, unpaid
- wages, unused airline tickets, and unidentified remittances; 39
- 40 except future and prior dividends made by the workers'
- compensation groups or associations described in paragraph (e); 41
- 42 (iii) Monies deposited to redeem stocks, bonds,
- coupons, and other securities, or to make distributions; 43
- 44 (iv) Amounts due and payable under the terms of
- 45 insurance policies;
- Amounts distributable from a trust or 46 (v)
- 47 custodial fund established under a plan to provide health,
- 48 welfare, pension, vacation, severance, retirement, death, stock
- 49 purchase, profit sharing, employee savings, supplemental
- unemployment insurance, or similar benefits; 50
- Shares of corporate stock and other 51 (vi)
- 52 intangible ownership interests in business associations; and
- 53 (vii) Bonds, notes and other debt obligations.
- 54 "Owner" means a depositor in case of a deposit, a (a)
- beneficiary in case of a trust, a creditor, claimant or payee in 55
- 56 case of other choses in action, or any person having a legal or
- 57 equitable interest in property subject to the provisions of this
- 58 act, or his legal representative.
- 59 "Apparent owner" means the person who appears from
- the records of the holder to be entitled to property held by the 60
- 61 holder.
- (i) "Person" means any individual, business 62
- 63 association, government or political subdivision or agency,
- 64 corporation, public authority, estate, trust, two (2) or more

- persons having a joint or common interest, or any other legal or 65
- 66 commercial entity whether such person is acting in his own right
- or in a representative capacity. 67
- (j) "Treasurer" means the State Treasurer of the State 68
- of Mississippi. 69
- 70 "Utility" means any person who owns or operates in
- this state for public use, any plant, equipment, property, 71
- franchise, or license for the transmission of communications or 72
- 73 the production, storage, transmission, sale, delivery, or
- furnishing of electricity, water, steam or gas. 74
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 75
- 76 and after July 1, 2006.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 89-12-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY CERTAIN DEFINITIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 2
