11	SECTION 1. The following highway is deleted from the state
12	highway system, removed from the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
13	Transportation Commission and returned to the jurisdiction of the
14	Board of Supervisors of Itawamba County:

16	Mississippi Highway 379 in Itawamba County.
17	<b>SECTION 2.</b> The following segment of highway is deleted from
18	the state highway system, removed from the jurisdiction of the
19	Mississippi Transportation Commission and returned to the
20	jurisdiction of the governing authorities of the City of Tunica,
21	Mississippi:
22	Northern District - Tunica County:
23	Mississippi Highway 4 beginning at the west corporate
24	limits of the City of Tunica, Mississippi, and extending
25	easterly to U.S. Highway 61, for a total approximate
26	length of .7 miles.
