- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Janis Keeton of Tunica County, Mississippi,
- 6 who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her conviction
- 7 of embezzlement in Tunica County, Mississippi, in 1991, and who
- 8 has completed the penalty and any conditions imposed upon her for
- 9 such conviction. The Legislature has been reliably informed that
- 10 she is now conducting herself as a law-abiding and honorable
- 11 citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 13 and after its passage.
