HOUSE BILL NO. 1807

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE
2 CITY OF BATESVILLE TO ALLOW COMMUNITY SERVICE CLUBS AND
3 ORGANIZATIONS TO USE THE OLD NATIONAL GUARD ARMORY WITHOUT CHARGE;
4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City
7 of Batesville are authorized and empowered, in their discretion,
8 by resolution duly adopted and entered on the minutes, to allow
9 community service clubs and organizations to use, on a rent-free
10 basis, certain real property located at the southeast corner of
11 the intersection of Highway 51 and Eureka Road, such property
12 being more particularly known as and referred to herein as the Old
13 National Guard Armory, with the utilities of the aforementioned
14 property being paid by the City of Batesville and the County of
15 Panola.

16 (2) The provisions of this section shall stand repealed on
17 December 31, 2012.

18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
19 and after its passage.
