HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 114

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE CORINTH HIGH
2 SCHOOL LADY WARRIORS CROSS COUNTRY TEAM AND THEIR COACH, KEN
3 WILLIAMS, FOR WINNING THEIR FOURTH CONSECUTIVE CLASS 3A STATE
4 CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOR DISPLAYING TIRELESS DEVOTION TO THEIR
5 ATHLETIC ENDEAVORS.

6 WHEREAS, the Corinth High School Lady Warriors Cross Country
7 Team have picked up their fourth consecutive cross country title
8 by winning the 2006 State 3A Championship; and

9 WHEREAS, leaving their competition in the dust by winning the
10 overall title by 19 points, the Lady Warriors had runners finish
11 in the top ten overall and be named All-State: Christina Coleman,
12 Lauren Foropoulos, Katlyn Will, Kelsey Ford and Ivy Price; and

13 WHEREAS, three team members won the top three positions:
14 Katlyn Will won the Gold Medal, Lauren Foropoulos won the Silver
15 Medal and Christina Coleman won the Bronze Medal; and

16 WHEREAS, Katlyn Will, a three-time individual State Champion,
17 wasted little time by finishing 53 seconds ahead of her nearest
18 competition by blazing a 14:39.31 time and setting new records;

20 WHEREAS, the entire Lady Warriors Cross Country Team: Katlyn
21 Will, Lauren Foropoulos, Christina Coleman, Kelsey Ford, Ivy
22 Price, Cynthia Cummins, Taylor Corder, Alex Hernandez, Wesley
23 Green, Laura Wall, Sarah Bullard and Abby Lambert performed well
24 throughout 2006 by setting several school records during the
25 season; and

26 WHEREAS, the Lady Warriors have been superbly coached and
27 inspired by Coach Ken Williams and Assistant Coach Dana Bullard,

28 who have motivated and challenged the Lady Warriors to strive for
29 their best; and

30 WHEREAS, the 2006 Lady Warriors have developed a winning and
31 cooperative spirit and a high degree of sportsmanship, and their
32 activities and attitude reflect great credit upon the individual
33 players and their coach and bring honor to Corinth High School;

35 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
36 recognize and commend excellence, especially when evidenced by the
37 youth of our state, who are its future:
