The Department of Finance and 17 Administration shall follow the procedure outlined by the United States Department of Health and Human Services in establishing 18 the fund, and the fund shall never exceed more than One Million 19 20 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) above and beyond four (4) months of operating expenses of the Department of Finance and 21 22 Administration.
