SENATE BILL NO. 2712

1 AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTIONS 41-59-65, 41-59-67, 41-59-69 AND
2 41-59-71, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH PROVIDE CERTAIN PERMIT
3 APPLICATION, FEE, BONDING, REPORTING AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS FOR A
4 LICENSED AMBULANCE SERVICE TO CONDUCT A MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTION
5 PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** Sections 41-59-65, 41-59-67, 41-59-69 and
8 41-59-71, Mississippi Code of 1972, which provide certain permit
9 application, fee, bonding, reporting and other requirements for a
10 licensed public or private service to conduct a membership
11 subscription program, are hereby repealed.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
13 and after July 1, 2007.
