5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. Section 55-23-8, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	55-23-8. (1) The Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium
9	Commission, in its discretion, is authorized to enter into one or
10	more lease agreements with one or more public or private entities
11	in regard to the granting of a property interest to such public or
12	private entities in all or any part of the real property located
13	in Hinds County, Mississippi, generally known as the "Mississippi
14	Veterans Memorial Stadium Property," being any property under the
15	jurisdiction of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium
16	Commission and any other state-owned property located in the area
17	bounded on the North by Taylor Street, on the West by North West
18	Street, on the South by Woodrow Wilson Avenue and on the East by
19	North State Street used as part of or in connection with
20	Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium, for the purpose of the
21	construction of improvements thereon.
22	(2) Any lease authorized in this section may be for such
23	consideration as determined appropriate by the Mississippi

Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission and may be for a primary term

not to exceed twenty-five (25) years and may be renewed for a term

not to exceed twenty-five (25) years. However, any lease

authorized under this section and entered into before the

effective date of Senate Bill No. 2745, 2007 Regular Session, may

any party leasing property from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial

95 Stadium Commission (or any designee or designees of any such 96 lessee), and/or any other party to provide or contribute funds in 97 connection with the construction, financing and/or operation of any improvements constructed on property leased from the 98 99 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, and any such 100 agreement or agreements and the obligations of any public body 101 thereunder shall not be included in computing amounts subject to 102 any debt limitations applicable to any such public body; and/or (b) agreements (which may extend over any period of time) to lease 103 104 property from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission 105 and to provide or contribute funds in connection with the 106 construction, financing and/or operation of any improvements 107 constructed on such property and to lease or sublease any such 108 property or improvements to public or private entities, and any such agreement or agreements shall not be included in computing 109 110 amounts subject to any debt limitations applicable to any such 111 public body.

- The Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, in 112 its discretion, is authorized to enter into all other agreements 113 114 as may be necessary or appropriate in connection with any 115 financing by any lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such 116 lessee or lessees) of any improvements to be constructed on 117 property leased from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium 118 Commission.
- 119 (6) The provisions of any statutes establishing a role for 120 the Department of Finance and Administration and the State Bond 121 Commission in financing, construction and improvement of buildings 122 on the Veterans Memorial Stadium property shall not apply to the financing, refinancing, construction, repair or improvement of any 123 124 improvements on any property leased pursuant to this section.
- (7) Before entering into any lease or other agreement with 125 126 any private entity under this section, the Mississippi Veterans 127 Memorial Stadium Commission shall require such entity to enter * SS06/ R1112* S. B. No. 2745

- 128 into a binding commitment providing that if the private entity
- 129 fails to complete the construction of all improvements commenced
- 130 by the entity on property leased under this section, such entity
- 131 shall reimburse the State of Mississippi for costs incurred by the
- 132 state relating to the improvements. The Department of Finance and
- 133 Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and
- 134 Real Property Management shall make the determination regarding
- 135 whether the construction of the improvements is complete.
- 136 (8) Any lease or other agreement entered into by the
- 137 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission under this
- 138 section shall not be valid unless approved by the Department of
- 139 Finance and Administration, the Public Procurement Review Board
- 140 and the Attorney General.
- 141 (9) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2), the
- 142 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission may not enter
- 143 into any lease or other agreement under this section after October
- 144 1, 2001.
- 145 (10) Any lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such
- 146 lessee or lessees) of property leased from the Mississippi
- 147 Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission under this section shall not
- 148 be considered as being the state, any political subdivision of the
- 149 state or any officer or servant of the state for the purposes of
- 150 any liability that may be waived under Section 11-46-1 et seq.,
- 151 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 152 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 153 and after July 1, 2007.
