SENATE BILL NO. 2962

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-5-151, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY THE INCORPORATION OF RURAL WATER ASSOCIATIONS INTO WATER DISTRICT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 19-5-151, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 19-5-151. (1) Any contiguous area situated within any
- 8 county of the state, and not being situated within the corporate
- 9 boundaries of any existing municipality, and having no adequate
- 10 water system, sewer system, garbage and waste collection and
- 11 disposal system, or fire protection facilities serving such area,
- 12 may become incorporated as a water district, as a sewer district,
- 13 as a garbage and waste collection and disposal district, as a fire
- 14 protection district, as a combined water and sewer district, as a
- 15 combined water and garbage and waste collection and disposal
- 16 district, as a combined water and fire protection district, or as
- 17 a combined water, sewer, garbage and waste collection and disposal
- 18 and fire protection district, in the manner set forth in the
- 19 following sections.
- 20 (2) If the certificated area * * * \underline{of} a nonprofit, nonshare
- 21 corporation chartered under the Mississippi Nonprofit Corporation
- 22 Act for the purpose of owning and operating rural waterworks <u>lies</u>
- 23 in one county, the corporation may become incorporated as a water
- 24 district in the manner set forth in Section 19-5-153(3). If the
- 25 nonprofit, nonshare corporation's certificated area lies in more
- 26 than one (1) county, the procedure in Section 19-5-164 shall be
- 27 used.

28 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
