PURPOSES.

SENATE BILL NO. 3049

AN ACT TO PROVIDE A PROCEDURE TO HELP COLLECT DELINQUENT MUNICIPAL, COUNTY, DISTRICT OR RURAL WATER BILLS; AND FOR RELATED

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. For purposes of this act: "Water sewer association" means any corporation, 6 (a) 7 whether for profit or not for profit, that provides, distributes, 8 transmits, treats, pumps, or stores raw or potable water to, or for the benefit of, members of the general public or commercial, 9 industrial and other users; and 10 11 (b) "Water sewer system" means any entity that provides, distributes, transmits, treats, pumps or stores raw or 12 potable water to or for the benefit of members of the general 13 public and commercial, industrial, and other users, including, 14 without limitation, the following entities that perform such 15 activities: 16 (i) Municipalities; 17 18 (ii) Counties; and (iii) Water sewer associations. 19 20 SECTION 2. When a person is delinquent on the payment of an undisputed bill for water sewer service provided by a water sewer 21 system within this state, moves into another area of this state, 22 and applies for or receives water from another water sewer system, 23 if the person's former water sewer system establishes that there 24 25 is no dispute that the delinquent amount is properly due and owed by that particular individual in that amount, the new water sewer 26 27 system shall refuse to provide water sewer service to the

28 delinquent person until such person provides proof of curing the 29 delinquency.

30 <u>SECTION 3.</u> No provision of this act shall apply to a water 31 sewer system that is regulated by the Mississippi Public Service 32 Commission as a "public utility" as defined in Section 77-3-3.

33 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after July 1, 2007.
