SENATE BILL NO. 3236

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MADISON
2 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO EMPLOY THE ELECTED COUNTY ATTORNEY ON A
3 FULL-TIME BASIS AND TO PROVIDE THE AMOUNT THAT SUCH PROSECUTING
4 ATTORNEY MAY BE COMPENSATED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Board of Supervisors of Madison County,
7 Mississippi, is authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to
8 employ the elected county prosecuting attorney on a full-time
9 basis during his or her term of office and may pay compensation to
10 such full-time prosecuting attorney in an amount of not more than
11 ninety percent (90%) of the annual compensation and salary of the
12 county court judges of the county as authorized by law.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
14 and after its passage.
