SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 20

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING BETH M. RILEY OF  
2 MANTACHIE, MISSISSIPPI, UPON THE OCCASION OF HER INSTALLATION AS  
3 2007-2008 GOVERNOR OF THE MISSISSIPPI DISTRICT PILOT  
4 INTERNATIONAL.

5 WHEREAS, Beth M. Riley of Mantachie, Mississippi, will be  
6 installed as Governor of the Mississippi District Pilot  
7 International on April 21, 2007, in Vicksburg, Mississippi. She  
8 will serve from July 1, 2007, until June 30, 2008. There are 22

11 Georgia. Today there are approximately 460 clubs in 6 countries;

19 Mantachie, Mississippi, for 20 years. She is a 6th Grade Math  
20 Teacher at Mantachie Elementary School and very active in her  
21 church and community; and

23 Mississippi citizen whose civic and charitable dedication for a  
24 worthwhile cause is a model of selfless service to her community  
25 and to the State of Mississippi:
