House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2516

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

S. B. 2516 PAGE 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

13	SECTION 1. Section 19-25-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
14	amended as follows:
15	19-25-13. The sheriff shall, at the July meeting of the
16	board of supervisors, submit a budget of estimated expenses of his
17	office for the ensuing fiscal year beginning October 1 in such
18	form as shall be prescribed by the Director of the State
19	Department of Audit. The board shall examine this proposed budget
20	and determine the amount to be expended by the sheriff in the
21	performance of his duties for the fiscal year and may increase or
22	reduce said amount as it deems necessary and proper.
23	The budget shall include amounts for compensating the
24	deputies and other employees of the sheriff's office, for
25	insurance providing protection for the sheriff and his deputies in
26	case of disability, death and other similar coverage, for travel
27	and transportation expenses of the sheriff and deputies, for
28	feeding prisoners and inmates of the county jail, and for such
29	other expenses as may be incurred in the performance of the duties
30	of the office of sheriff. In addition, the budget shall include
31	amounts for the payment of premiums on bonds and insurance for the
32	sheriff and his deputies which, in the opinion of the board of
33	supervisors, are deemed necessary to protect the interests of the
34	county or the sheriff and his deputies. Such amounts may include
35	official bonds and any bonds required of his deputies by the
36	sheriff; liability insurance; insurance against false arrest
37	charges; insurance against false imprisonment charges; theft, fire
38	and other hazards insurance; and hospitalization insurance as

provided for in Sections 25-15-101 and 25-15-103. The board may 39 40 authorize the reimbursement of the sheriff and deputies for the use of privately owned automobiles or other motor vehicles in the 41 42 performance of official duties at the rate provided by law for 43 state officers and employees, or may authorize the purchase by the sheriff of such motor vehicles and such equipment as may be needed 44 for operation of the sheriff's office, such vehicles and equipment 45 46 to be owned by the county. In counties which have elected to purchase the motor vehicles and such equipment for the operation 47 of the sheriff's office, if a sheriff or deputy shall be required 48 49 in the performance of his official duties, in the event of an 50 emergency, to use his privately owned automobile or other motor 51 vehicle, the board of supervisors may, in its discretion, authorize the reimbursement for such use at the rate per mile 52 53 provided by law for state officers and employees. This shall not be construed as giving an officer a choice of whether to use his 54 55 own or the county's vehicle, but shall be construed so as not to 56 penalize an officer who must use his own vehicle because the 57 county's vehicle was not available. The board of supervisors, in its discretion, may include in 58 59 its annual budget for the sheriff's office an amount not to exceed 60 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), which may be expended by the sheriff to provide food, water and beverages for the sheriff, the 61 sheriff's deputies, state, national and local law enforcement 62 officers, emergency personnel, county employees and members of the 63 64 general public who the sheriff requests to assist him and his 65 office while in the performance of search and rescue missions, 66 disasters or other emergency operations. The board of supervisors may acquire one or more credit cards 67 which may be used by the sheriff and his deputies to pay expenses 68 69 incurred by them when traveling in or out of state in the performance of their official duties. The chancery clerk or 70

county purchase clerk shall maintain complete records of all

to the use of such credit cards. The sheriff shall furnish

credit card numbers and all receipts and other documents relating

74 receipts for the use of such credit cards each month to the 75 chancery clerk or purchase clerk who shall submit a written report monthly to the board of supervisors, which report shall include an 76 77 itemized list of all expenditures and use of the credit cards for 78 the month, and such expenditures may be allowed for payment by the county in the same manner as other items on the claims docket. The 79 80 issuance of a credit card to a sheriff or his deputy under the 81 provisions of this section shall not be construed to authorize 82 such sheriff or deputy sheriff to use such credit card to make any expenditure which is not otherwise authorized by law. 83 84 The board of supervisors is hereby authorized and empowered, 85 in its discretion, to appropriate and pay a sum not to exceed Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) annually as a clothing allowance to each 86 plainclothes investigator employed by the sheriff's office of such 87 88 The board of supervisors of any county bordering on the Gulf of Mexico and having a population of more than thirty-one 89 90 thousand seven hundred (31,700) but less than thirty-one thousand 91 eight hundred (31,800) according to the 1990 Federal Census may 92 appropriate and pay a sum not to exceed Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) annually as a clothing allowance to the administrator of 93 94 the county jail.

The board of supervisors shall, at its first meeting of each quarter beginning on October 1, January 1, April 1 and July 1, appropriate a lump sum for the sheriff for the expenses of his office during the current quarter. The quarterly appropriation shall be one-fourth (1/4) of the amount approved in the annual budget unless the sheriff requests a different amount. Except in case of emergency, as provided in the county budget law, the appropriation for the quarter beginning in October of the last year of the sheriff's term shall not exceed one-fourth (1/4) of the annual budget.

The sheriff shall file a report of all expenses of his office incurred during the preceding month with the board of supervisors for approval at its regular monthly meeting in a form to be prescribed by the Director of the State Department of Audit, and

109 upon filing thereof, and approval by the board, the clerk of the

110 board shall issue warrants in payment thereof but not to exceed

111 the budget appropriation for that quarter. Any appropriated funds

112 which are unexpended at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in

113 the county general fund.

The budget for the sheriff's office may be revised at any

115 regular meeting by the board of supervisors. Upon recommendation

116 of the sheriff, the board may at any regular meeting make

117 supplemental appropriations to the sheriff's office.

Any fees previously required to be paid by a sheriff shall be

119 paid by the board of supervisors by including the estimates

120 therefor in the sheriff's budget. All fees and charges for

121 services heretofore collected by sheriffs shall be collected by

122 said sheriff and paid monthly into the general fund of the

123 concerned county. However, any fees heretofore collected by such

124 sheriffs from the county shall not be paid.

125 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

126 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-25-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ANY COUNTY, IN ITS DISCRETION, TO INCLUDE IN ITS ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE SHERIFF'S

4 OFFICE AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR

5 EXPENDITURE BY THE SHERIFF TO PROVIDE FOOD, WATER AND BEVERAGES

6 FOR THE SHERIFF, THE SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES, STATE, NATIONAL AND LOCAL

7 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, EMERGENCY PERSONNEL, COUNTY EMPLOYEES

8 AND MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC WHO THE SHERIFF REQUESTS TO

9 ASSIST HIM AND HIS OFFICE WHILE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF SEARCH AND

10 RESCUE MISSIONS, DISASTERS OR OTHER EMERGENCY OPERATIONS; AND FOR

11 RELATED PURPOSES.
