House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3189

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 8 **SECTION 1.** (1) There shall be allowed as a credit against
- 9 the taxes imposed by this chapter fifty percent (50%) of the
- 10 amount of any costs and expenses incurred by the taxpayer, not to
- 11 exceed Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per year, for
- 12 purchasing and installing insulation, energy-efficient replacement
- 13 windows and high-efficiency heating and cooling equipment to
- 14 eligible property. The credit that may be utilized in each year
- 15 shall be limited to the amount of income tax imposed on the
- 16 taxpayer for the taxable year.
- 17 (2) The tax credit authorized by this section shall apply
- 18 only to improvements made to eligible property during calendar
- 19 years 2007 and 2008.
- 20 (3) To claim the credit authorized pursuant to this section,
- 21 the taxpayer shall attach a copy of the tax receipt for homestead
- 22 exemption on the eligible property along with supporting
- 23 documentation as to the improvements made to the eligible property
- 24 to all income tax returns upon which the credit is claimed.
- 25 (4) As used in this section, "eligible property" means
- 26 property located in Mississippi used for residential purposes
- 27 owned by the taxpayer and upon which homestead exemption is
- 28 granted.
- 29 (5) This section shall stand repealed on January 1, 2009.
- 30 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this act shall be codified in
- 31 Chapter 7, Title 27, Mississippi Code of 1972.

32 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after January 1, 2007, and shall stand repealed from and after

34 January 2, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
