

## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 909

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

44        SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a  
45 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge  
46 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as  
47 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup  
48 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of  
49 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this  
50 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor  
51 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a  
52 supporter of the Mississippi State Equine Association. The  
53 distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and  
54 design as the State Tax Commission, with the advice of the  
55 Mississippi State Equine Association, may prescribe and shall  
56 consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary  
57 to distinguish each license tag.

58        (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized  
59 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms  
60 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the  
61 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less  
62 Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax collector, shall be  
63 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as  
64 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee  
65 retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county  
66 general fund.

67        (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or  
68 after July 1, 2007, any person applying for a distinctive license  
69 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount

70 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag  
71 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all  
72 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a  
73 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established  
74 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the  
75 time the original application is made for a distinctive license  
76 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of  
77 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive  
78 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive  
79 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax  
80 collector.

81 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the  
82 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,  
83 the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected  
84 under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute  
85 such collections as follows:

86 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee  
87 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
88 section shall be distributed to the Mississippi State Equine  
89 Association.

90 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
91 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall  
92 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Fund created pursuant  
93 to Section 7-9-70.

94 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee  
95 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
96 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund  
97 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or  
98 reconstruction of highways.

99 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
100 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall  
101 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section  
102 27-19-44.2.

103 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as  
104 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under

105 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the  
106 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under  
107 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license  
108 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,  
109 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license  
110 tag.

111 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license  
112 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and  
113 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by  
114 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license  
115 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving  
116 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and  
117 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee  
118 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be  
119 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular  
120 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

121 **SECTION 2.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a  
122 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge  
123 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as  
124 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup  
125 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of  
126 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this  
127 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor  
128 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a  
129 supporter of Lamar Christian School. The distinctive license tags  
130 so issued shall display the words "Lamar Christian School" and  
131 shall be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission,  
132 with the advice of the principal of Lamar Christian School, may  
133 prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both,  
134 as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag.

135 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized  
136 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms  
137 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the  
138 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less  
139 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,

140 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis  
141 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional  
142 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the  
143 county general fund.

144 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or  
145 after July 1, 2007, any person applying for a distinctive license  
146 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount  
147 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag  
148 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all  
149 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a  
150 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established  
151 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the  
152 time the original application is made for a distinctive license  
153 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of  
154 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive  
155 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive  
156 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax  
157 collector.

158 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the  
159 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,  
160 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the  
161 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the  
162 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State  
163 Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

164 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee  
165 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
166 section shall be distributed to Lamar Christian School.

167 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
168 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall  
169 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Fund created pursuant  
170 to Section 7-9-70.

171 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee  
172 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
173 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund

174 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or  
175 reconstruction of highways.

176 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
177 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall  
178 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section  
179 27-19-44.2.

180 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as  
181 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under  
182 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the  
183 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under  
184 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license  
185 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,  
186 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license  
187 tag.

188 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license  
189 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and  
190 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by  
191 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license  
192 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving  
193 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and  
194 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee  
195 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be  
196 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular  
197 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

198 **SECTION 3.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle, who is a  
199 resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws  
200 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon  
201 payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes  
202 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of  
203 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles,  
204 and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount  
205 provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a  
206 special license tag for each motor vehicle registered in his name  
207 identifying such person as a supporter of Baptist Homes, Inc. The  
208 distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and

209 design as the State Tax Commission, with the advice of Baptist  
210 Homes, Inc., may prescribe, shall have "SON Valley" inscribed upon  
211 it and shall consist of the such letters or numbers, or both, as  
212 may be necessary to distinguish each license tag.

213 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized  
214 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms  
215 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the  
216 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less  
217 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,  
218 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis  
219 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional  
220 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the  
221 county general fund.

222 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or  
223 after July 1, 2007, any person applying for a distinctive license  
224 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount  
225 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag  
226 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all  
227 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a  
228 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established

242 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee  
243 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
244 section shall be disbursed to Baptist Homes, Inc.

245 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
246 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall  
247 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Center Fund created  
248 pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

249 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee  
250 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
251 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund  
252 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or  
253 reconstruction of highways.

254 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
255 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall  
256 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section  
257 27-19-44.2.

258 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as  
259 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under  
260 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the  
261 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under  
262 this section. The tax collector shall issue month and year decals  
263 for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which  
264 will expire the same month and year as the regular license tag.

265 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license  
266 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and  
267 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by  
268 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license  
269 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving  
270 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and  
271 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee  
272 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be  
273 distributed proportionately in the same manner as funds from the  
274 sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this  
275 section.

276           **SECTION 4.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a  
277 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge  
278 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as  
279 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup  
280 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of  
281 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this  
282 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor  
283 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a  
284 supporter of the Mississippi Police Benevolent Association. The  
285 distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and  
286 design as the State Tax Commission, with the advice of the  
287 Mississippi Police Benevolent Association, may prescribe and shall  
288 consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary  
289 to distinguish each license tag.

290           (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized  
291 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms  
292 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the  
293 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less  
294 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,  
295 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis  
296 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional  
297 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the  
298 county general fund.

981 the International Symbol of Access adopted by Rehabilitation  
982 International in 1969 at its Eleventh World Congress on  
983 Rehabilitation of the Disabled for not more than two (2) vehicles  
984 that are registered in the applicant's name. The initial  
985 application shall be accompanied by the certification of a  
986 licensed physician that (a) the applicant meets the definition of  
987 persons with disabilities which limit or impair the ability to  
988 walk; and (b) that the physician has determined that the applicant  
989 will have the disability for at least five (5) years. The State  
990 Tax Commission shall prepare and issue to the tax collectors of  
991 the various counties, decals for placement on the special license  
992 plates. The decals shall bear thereon the month in which the  
993 license plate was issued and the year in which the special license  
994 plate will expire. The special license plate issued under this  
995 section is valid for the period of time that the license tag  
996 attached upon a motor vehicle is issued pursuant to Section  
997 27-19-31(1). A person to whom the special license plate is issued  
998 may retain the special license plate and may renew it by  
999 submitting to the county tax collector, on or before its  
1000 expiration, the certification of a licensed physician that the  
1001 physician has determined (a) that the applicant meets the  
1002 definition of a person with a disability which limits or impairs  
1003 the ability to walk; and (b) that the applicant will have the  
1004 disability for at least five (5) years. If an applicant fails to  
1005 renew the special license plate before its date of expiration,  
1006 then he shall surrender the special license plate to the county

1007 tax collector and the tax collector shall issue to such person a  
1008 regular license plate to replace the special license plate.

1009 The terms "vehicle" and "motor vehicle," as used in this  
1010 section, includes motorcycles.

1011 The term "persons with disabilities which limit or impair the  
1012 ability to walk" when used in this section means those persons  
1013 who, as determined by a licensed physician:

1014 (a) Cannot walk two hundred (200) feet without stopping  
1015 to rest; or

1016 (b) Cannot walk without the use of, or assistance from,  
1017 a brace, cane, crutch, another person, prosthetic device,  
1018 wheelchair, or other assistive device; or

1019 (c) Are restricted by lung disease to such an extent  
1020 that the person's forced (respiratory) expiratory volume for one  
1021 (1) second, when measured by spirometry, is less than one (1)  
1022 liter, or the arterial oxygen tension is less than sixty (60)  
1023 mm/hg on room air at rest; or

1024 (d) Use portable oxygen; or

1025 (e) Have a cardiac condition to the extent that the  
1026 person's functional limitations are classified in severity as  
1027 Class III or Class IV according to standards set by the American  
1028 Heart Association; or

1029 (f) Are severely limited in their ability to walk due  
1030 to an arthritic, neurological or orthopedic condition.

1031 An applicant for a special license plate bearing the  
1032 International Symbol of Access shall not be required to pay any  
1033 fee or charge for the issuance of such license plate separate from  
1034 or in addition to the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem  
1035 taxes and registration fees otherwise required by law to be paid  
1036 for the issuance of a regular license plate for such vehicle.

1037 (2) The State Tax Commission shall prepare removable  
1038 windshield placards and such placards shall be issued and  
1039 periodically renewed upon the applications of persons with  
1040 disabilities which limit or impair the ability to walk. The  
1041 placards shall be issued, free of charge, to applicants through

1042 the offices of the tax collectors of the counties. The initial  
1043 application shall be accompanied by the certification of a  
1044 licensed physician that the applicant meets the definition of  
1045 persons with disabilities which limit or impair the ability to  
1046 walk. These placards shall be valid for the period of time that  
1047 the license tag attached upon a motor vehicle is issued pursuant  
1048 to Section 27-19-31(1) and may be renewed in the same manner as  
1049 provided for the renewal of the special license plates under  
1050 subsection (1) of this section. The removable windshield placard  
1051 must be displayed on the left side of the vehicle dashboard or by  
1052 hanging it on the rearview mirror of the vehicle. The State Tax  
1053 Commission shall prescribe the placement for motorcycles.

1054 (3) The State Tax Commission shall provide for the issuance  
1055 of a temporary removable windshield placard, upon the application  
1056 of a person with a disability which limits or impairs the ability  
1057 to walk. Temporary removable windshield placards authorized by  
1058 this subsection shall be prepared by the State Tax Commission and  
1059 shall be issued, free of charge, to applicants through the offices  
1060 of the tax collectors of the counties. Application for a  
1061 temporary removable windshield placard must be accompanied by the  
1062 certification of a licensed physician that the applicant meets the  
1063 definition of persons with disabilities which limit or impair the  
1064 ability to walk. The certification shall also include the period  
1065 of time that the physician determines the applicant will have the  
1066 disability, not to exceed six (6) months. The temporary removable  
1067 windshield placard must be displayed on the left side of the  
1068 vehicle dashboard or by hanging it on the rearview mirror of the  
1069 vehicle. The temporary removable windshield placard shall be  
1070 valid for a period of time for which the physician has determined  
1071 that the applicant will have the disability, not to exceed six (6)  
1072 months from the date of issuance. The State Tax Commission shall  
1073 prescribe the placement for motorcycles.

1074 (4) The removable windshield placard and the temporary  
1075 removable windshield placard shall be two-sided and shall include:

1076           (a) The International Symbol of Access, which is at  
1077 least three (3) inches in height, centered on the placard (the  
1078 color of the removable windshield placard shall be white on a blue  
1079 shield; and the temporary removable windshield placard shall be  
1080 white on a red shield);

1081           (b) An identification number and, on the reverse side,  
1082 the name of the individual to whom the placard is issued;

1083           (c) A date of expiration; and

1084           (d) The seal of the State of Mississippi.

1085           (5) (a) It shall be unlawful to park a motor vehicle in an  
1086 area set aside for persons who are disabled if the motor vehicle  
1087 does not (i) have displayed the removable windshield placard  
1088 authorized in this section with the date of expiration visible,  
1089 (ii) have the special license plate issued under this section  
1090 properly displayed upon the motor vehicle, or (iii) have the  
1091 disabled American veteran tag or plate issued under Section  
1092 27-19-53 properly displayed upon the motor vehicle. Any person  
1093 who unlawfully parks a motor vehicle in such areas, or who blocks  
1094 such spaces or access thereto, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor  
1095 and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than Two  
1096 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each such violation. For the third  
1097 and subsequent offenses under this section, the offender's  
1098 driver's license shall be suspended for ninety (90) days by the  
1099 Commissioner of Public Safety in accordance with Section 63-1-53  
1100 in addition to any fine imposed. The court shall not suspend or  
1101 reduce any fine required to be imposed under this subsection.

1102           (b) A person who is charged with a violation of this  
1103 section by parking a motor vehicle in an area set aside for  
1104 persons who are disabled and failing properly to display (i) a  
1105 removable windshield placard on the dash of the vehicle or by  
1106 hanging it on the rearview mirror of the vehicle, (ii) a special  
1107 license plate issued under this section upon the vehicle or (iii)  
1108 a disabled American veteran tag or plate issued under Section  
1109 27-19-53 upon the vehicle shall not be convicted and shall have  
1110 the charge dismissed upon presentation to the court of proof by

1111 means of sworn oral testimony or sworn affidavit that at the time  
1112 of the charged violation he or a passenger in the vehicle  
1113 possessed a valid removable windshield placard issued under this  
1114 section.

1115 (6) Any person who, for the purpose of obtaining a special  
1116 license plate or windshield placard under this section, files with  
1117 the county tax collector a physician's certification, knowing the  
1118 certification to be false or to have been fraudulently obtained,  
1119 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be  
1120 fined not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

1121 (7) All law enforcement officers are authorized to enforce  
1122 this section on public and private property. Provision of spaces  
1123 restricted to handicapped parking and proper marking of such  
1124 spaces shall be considered as intent and permission to enforce  
1125 such designated parking on private property. Any owner of private  
1126 property may tow away a vehicle that is parked on the owner's  
1127 private property in violation of the disabled parking restrictions  
1128 set forth in this section at the vehicle owner's expense. In  
1129 addition, the vehicle owner may be subject to any fines or other  
1130 penalties provided in this section. Only areas marked in  
1131 accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility  
1132 Guidelines or equivalent standards shall be enforced. Spaces  
1133 shall bear the International Symbol of Access.

1134 (8) Motor vehicles displaying a special license plate,  
1135 license plate decal, placard or parking certificate or permit  
1136 bearing the International Symbol of Access issued to a person with  
1137 a disability by any other state or district subject to the laws of  
1138 the United States shall be allowed the special parking privileges  
1139 under this section provided the license plate, decal, placard,  
1140 permit or certificate bears the International Symbol of Access and  
1141 is displayed in a prominent place on the vehicle.

1142 (9) Parking in any area set aside for persons who are  
1143 disabled is limited to vehicles which, immediately before or after  
1144 the utilization of such an area, are used to transport a person  
1145 with a disability which limits or impairs the ability to walk.



1146 The identification required to park in such an area, except as  
1147 provided in subsection (8) of this section, is as follows:

1148 (a) For a vehicle used to transport a person with a  
1149 permanent disability, that person's permanent windshield placard  
1150 must be displayed or the vehicle must have a special license tag  
1151 issued under this section or Section 27-19-53 properly displayed.

1152 (b) For a vehicle being used by a person who has a  
1153 temporary disability which limits or impairs the ability to walk,  
1154 or which is being used to transport such a person, a temporary  
1155 windshield placard must be displayed.

1156 Any person who parks in an area set aside for persons who are  
1157 disabled in violation of this subsection shall be punished as  
1158 provided for in subsection (5) of this section.

1159 (10) Upon application by a nursing home, retirement home or  
1160 other institution that transports disabled persons, the State Tax  
1161 Commission may issue the special license plate authorized pursuant  
1162 to this section for not more than one (1) vehicle that is  
1163 registered in the applicant's name that is used to transport  
1164 disabled residents of the institution. Such institution shall  
1165 comply with all other laws regarding the registration of such  
1166 vehicle.

1167 **SECTION 14.** Section 27-19-56.94, Mississippi Code of 1972,  
1168 is amended as follows:

1169 27-19-56.94. (1) Beginning with any registration year  
1170 commencing on or after July 1, 2005, owners of motor vehicles upon  
1171 complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and  
1172 licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the road and  
1173 bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as  
1174 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup  
1175 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of  
1176 an additional annual fee in the amount provided in subsection (3)  
1177 of this section, shall be entitled to a distinctive license tag  
1178 that demonstrates their appreciation of blues music. The tags  
1179 shall be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission  
1180 prescribes subject to the approval of the Mississippi License Tag

1181 Commission; however, each tag shall display the words  
1182 "Mississippi, Home of the Blues" and shall consist of such letters  
1183 or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each  
1184 license tag.

1185 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags shall be  
1186 made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State  
1187 Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee imposed  
1188 under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00)  
1189 thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to  
1190 the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the  
1191 commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax  
1192 collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.

1193 (3) \* \* \* Any person applying for a distinctive license tag  
1194 under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount of  
1195 Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag applied  
1196 for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other  
1197 taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of  
1198 time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag  
1199 year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the  
1200 original application is made for a distinctive license tag under  
1201 this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal  
1202 registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license  
1203 tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license  
1204 tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector.

1205 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the  
1206 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,  
1207 the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected  
1208 under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute  
1209 such collections as follows:

1210 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee  
1211 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
1212 section shall be deposited into the special fund created in  
1213 subsection (7) of this section.

1214 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
1215 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall

1216 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn  
1217 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

1218 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee  
1219 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
1220 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund  
1221 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or  
1222 reconstruction of highways.

1223 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
1224 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall  
1225 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section  
1226 27-19-44.2.

1227 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as  
1228 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under  
1229 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the  
1230 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under  
1231 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license  
1232 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,  
1233 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license  
1234 tag.

1235 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license  
1236 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and  
1237 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by  
1238 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license  
1239 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving  
1240 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and  
1241 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee  
1242 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be  
1243 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular  
1244 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

1245 (7) There is established in the State Treasury a special  
1246 fund to be known as the Blues Heritage Fund which shall consist of  
1247 monies required to be deposited therein under subsection (4) of  
1248 this section. Through July 1, 2008, monies in the special fund  
1249 shall be appropriated by the Legislature to the Mississippi Blues  
1250 Commission created pursuant to Section 39-27-1. Thereafter monies

1251 from the special fund shall be appropriated by the Legislature for  
1252 projects that preserve and promote Mississippi's blues music  
1253 heritage. Unexpended amounts remaining in the special fund at the  
1254 end of the fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General  
1255 Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings on amounts in  
1256 the special fund shall be deposited to the credit of the special  
1257 fund.

1258 (8) In order for a distinctive tag to be issued under this  
1259 section, the provisions of Section 27-19-44(2) must be satisfied  
1260 prior to July 1, 2010.

1261 **SECTION 15.** Section 27-19-44, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
1262 amended as follows:

1263 27-19-44. (1) For any distinctive license tag or plate  
1264 authorized by the Legislature from and after July 1, 2000, through  
1265 June 30, 2002, or authorized by Sections 27-19-56.37 and  
1266 27-19-56.55, the requirements of this subsection must be met  
1267 before the State Tax Commission may prepare or issue any such  
1268 license tag or plate. The organization or other entity for which  
1269 the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate  
1270 must submit proof satisfactory to the State Tax Commission that at  
1271 least one hundred (100) of such license tags or plates will be  
1272 purchased and must deposit with the commission an amount necessary  
1273 to purchase one hundred (100) of such license tags or plates. The  
1274 organization or other entity for which the Legislature authorized  
1275 the distinctive license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements  
1276 of this subsection (1) within two (2) years after the effective  
1277 date of the law authorizing the license tag or plate in order to  
1278 permit the license tag or plate to be prepared and issued.

1279 (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (1) of this  
1280 section, any distinctive license tag or plate authorized by the  
1281 Legislature from and after July 1, 2002, through June 30, 2007,  
1282 the requirements of this subsection must be met before the State  
1283 Tax Commission may prepare or issue any such license tag or plate.  
1284 The organization or other entity for which the Legislature  
1285 authorized the distinctive license tag or plate must submit proof

1286 satisfactory to the State Tax Commission that at least two hundred  
1287 (200) of such license tags or plates will be purchased and must  
1288 deposit with the commission an amount necessary to purchase two  
1289 hundred (200) of such license tags or plates. The organization or  
1290 other entity for which the Legislature authorized the distinctive  
1291 license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements of this  
1292 subsection (2) within three (3) years after the effective date of  
1293 the law authorizing the license tag or plate in order to permit  
1294 the license tag or plate to be prepared and issued.

1295 (3) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any  
1296 distinctive license tag or plate authorized by the Legislature  
1297 from and after July 1, 2007, the requirements of this subsection  
1298 must be met before the State Tax Commission may prepare or issue  
1299 any such license tag or plate. The organization or other entity  
1300 for which the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag  
1301 or plate must submit proof satisfactory to the State Tax  
1302 Commission that at least three hundred (300) of such license tags  
1303 or plates will be purchased and must deposit with the commission  
1304 an amount necessary to purchase three hundred (300) of such  
1305 license tags or plates. The organization or other entity for  
1306 which the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or  
1307 plate must satisfy the requirements of this subsection (3) within  
1308 three (3) years after the effective date of the law authorizing  
1309 the license tag or plate in order to permit the license tag or  
1310 plate to be prepared and issued.

1311 (4) If the organization or other entity for which the  
1312 Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate meets  
1313 the requirements of subsection (1), (2) or (3) of this section,  
1314 the State Tax Commission shall prepare and issue the distinctive  
1315 license tag or plate.

1316 (5) The State Tax Commission shall review the number of  
1317 distinctive or special license tags or plates issued pursuant to  
1318 this chapter during the period for the license tag or plate  
1319 series. If the number of any distinctive or special license tag  
1320 or plate issued pursuant to this chapter falls below one hundred

1321 (100) in the last year of the license tag or plate series, the  
1322 distinctive or special license tag or plate shall be discontinued  
1323 at the end of the period for the license tag or plate series.

1324 (6) If a distinctive or special license tag or plate is  
1325 discontinued under subsection (5) of this section, the  
1326 organization or other entity for which the license tag or plate  
1327 was discontinued may prepare a distinctive or special license tag  
1328 or plate decal. The distinctive or special license tag or plate  
1329 decal shall be of such size, color and design as may be agreed  
1330 upon by the organization or other entity and the State Tax  
1331 Commission. However, the State Tax Commission shall have final  
1332 approval of the size, color and design of the decal. The  
1333 distinctive or special license tag or plate decals shall be  
1334 prepared and sold by the organization or other entity, and the  
1335 proceeds derived from the sale of such decals shall be retained by  
1336 the organization or other entity for any use deemed appropriate by  
1337 the organization or other entity.

1338 (7) The provisions of this section shall not apply to  
1339 distinctive or special license tags or plates:

1340 (a) Which are issued under Section 27-19-45, 27-19-46,  
1341 27-19-47.1, 27-19-47.2, 27-19-48, 27-19-49, 27-19-53, 27-19-55,  
1342 27-19-56, 27-19-56.1, 27-19-56.2, 27-19-56.3, 27-19-56.5,  
1343 27-19-56.6, 27-19-56.9, 27-19-56.11, 27-19-56.12, 27-19-56.13,  
1344 27-19-56.62, 27-19-56.69, 27-19-56.79 or 27-19-56.137; or

1345 (b) For which no additional fee is required to be paid.

1346 **SECTION 16.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
1347 and after July 1, 2007.
