Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1670

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 36 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 37 38 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 39 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 40 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall maintain 41 42 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 43 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 44 45 maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 46 47 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 48 49 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request 50 process. In the event of a natural disaster or other major 51 SECTION 4. catastrophe whereby the expenditure of funds above the limits 52 53 contained herein are deemed necessary to rapidly repair or restore port facilities, the Port Authority and the Mississippi 54 55 Development Authority, with the approval of the Department of Finance and Administration, may escalate expenditures under 56 57 Section 1 and the major objects contained in Section 2. 58 no escalation shall be authorized until source and availability of such funds is shown. 59 60 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 61 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport is hereby authorized to escalate and expend funds from any source in accordance with 62 applicable rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 63 64 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of

federal funds.

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66 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that

67 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

- 68 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 69 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 70 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 71 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 72 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 73 made without competitive bids.
- 74 **SECTION 7.** The money appropriated under the provisions of
- 75 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper
- 76 person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 77 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 78 and after July 1, 2007.
