## HOUSE BILL NO. 125

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF CELLULAR TELEPHONES WITHOUT
  USING HANDS-FREE ACCESSORIES WHILE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE; TO
  PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) It is unlawful for any person to use a
- 6 cellular telephone without using hands-free accessories while
- 7 operating a motor vehicle. The term "hands-free accessories," as
- 8 used in this section, means a device or devices that allow a motor
- 9 vehicle operator to speak on a cellular telephone without holding
- 10 the telephone or some part of the telephone with his hands.
- 11 (2) The prohibitions of subsection (1) of this section shall
- 12 not apply to calls made solely to E911 and calls made while the
- 13 vehicle is parked.
- 14 (3) Any person who violates the provisions of this section
- 15 is subject to the following penalties:
- 16 (a) Upon conviction of a first offense, the person
- 17 shall be fined not more than One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00).
- 18 (b) Upon conviction of a second offense, the offenses
- 19 having been committed within a three-year period, the person shall
- 20 be fined not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00).
- 21 (c) Upon conviction of a third or subsequent offense,
- 22 the offenses having been committed within a three-year period, the
- 23 person shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars
- (\$500.00), shall be imprisoned for not more than six (6) months in
- 25 the county jail and shall be sentenced to community service work
- 26 for not less than ten (10) days.

- 27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 28 and after July 1, 2011.
