- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** State law shall occupy and preempt the entire
- 8 field of legislation in this state relating in any way to the
- 9 regulation of inattentive driving and cellular phone usage in
- 10 motor vehicles, to the complete exclusion of any order, ordinance
- 11 or regulation by any county, municipality or other political
- 12 subdivision of this state. Any order, ordinance or regulation in
- 13 this field enacted before or after the effective date of this act
- 14 by any county, municipality or other political subdivision of this
- 15 state is null and void.
- SECTION 2. Section 63-3-212, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 17 amended as follows:
- 18 63-3-212. No county, municipality or other political
- 19 subdivision shall enact any ordinance restricting the use of
- 20 cellular phones in any motor vehicle unless the state * * *
- 21 authorizes a county, municipality or other political subdivision
- 22 to enact that type of an ordinance.
- 23 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2011.
