HOUSE BILL NO. 581

1 AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 37-18-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
 2 TO WHICH REQUIRES THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ESTABLISH A
 3 PROGRAM OF DEVELOPMENT FOR SCHOOLS DESIGNATED AS SCHOOLS AT-RISK
 4 FOR FAILING TO MEET ACCREDITATION STANDARDS, AND WHICH ALSO
 5 PROVIDES FOR ADDITIONAL MAEP FUNDS FOR THE ASSISTANCE OF SUCH
 6 PROGRAMS, AND WHICH REQUIRES AN EVALUATION TEAM TO ANALYZE DATA
 7 FOR SUCH PROGRAMS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-18-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, which
 10 requires the State Board of Education to establish a program of
 11 development for schools designated as Schools At-Risk for failing
 12 to meet accreditation standards, and which also provides for
 13 additional MAEP funds for the assistance of such programs, and
 14 which requires an evaluation team to analyze data for such
 15 programs, is hereby repealed.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
 17 and after July 1, 2017.
