SENATE BILL NO. 2710 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT A STATE AGENCY, DEPARTMENT, POLITICAL 2 SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE, COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY, UNIVERSITY, 3 COLLEGE, COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR JUNIOR COLLEGE, OR ANY AGENT, 4 EMPLOYEE OR OFFICER THEREOF FROM CREATING, PLANNING, IMPLEMENTING, 5 ASSISTING, PARTICIPATING IN, OR ENABLING A SANCTUARY POLICY; TO 6 PROVIDE THAT ANY SANCTUARY POLICY ADOPTED IN VIOLATION OF THIS ACT 7 SHALL BE INVALID AND VOID FROM THE DATE OF ITS ADOPTION OR 8 ENACTMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 SECTION 1. (1) No state agency, department, political
- 11 subdivision of this state, county, municipality, university,
- 12 college, community college or junior college, or any agent,
- employee or officer thereof shall adopt, or implement a policy, 13
- 14 order or ordinance that (a) limits or prohibits any person from
- 15 communicating or cooperating with federal agencies or officials to
- 16 verify or report the immigration status of any person; or (b)
- grants to any person the right to lawful presence or status within 17
- the state, a county or municipality, or the campus of a 18
- 19 university, college, community college or junior college in
- 20 violation of state or federal law.
