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- 1 AMEND after line 186 by inserting the following new section
- 2 and renumbering the succeeding section:
- 3 SECTION . Section 17-23-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 4 amended as follows:
- 5 17-23-1. (1) There is established the Rural Fire Truck
- 6 Acquisition Assistance Program to be administered by the
- 7 Department of Insurance for the purpose of assisting counties and
- 8 municipalities in the acquisition of fire trucks, firefighting
- 9 equipment and/or personal protective equipment and related gear.
- 10 (2) There is created in the State Treasury a special fund to
- 11 be designated as the "Rural Fire Truck Fund." The Legislature may
- 12 appropriate that amount necessary to fulfill the obligations

- 13 created under this section by the Department of Insurance, from
- 14 the State General Fund to such special fund, which sum shall be
- 15 added to the remainder of the money transferred on July 1, 1995,
- 16 and during the 1996 Regular Session to the Rural Fire Truck Fund.
- 17 Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal
- 18 year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest
- 19 earned on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of
- 20 the fund. Unobligated amounts remaining in the Rural Fire Truck
- 21 Fund, Fund No. 3507, or in Fund No. 3508, or in Fund No. 3504, or
- 22 in any fund created for funds appropriated or otherwise made
- 23 available for this program, may be used as matching funds by any
- 24 county with remaining eligibility as provided herein. It is the
- 25 intent of the Legislature that the Department of Insurance
- 26 continue to accept applications from the counties for fire trucks
- 27 as provided in subsection (3) of this section.
- 28 (3) (a) A county that meets the requirements provided
- 29 herein may receive an amount not to exceed * * * Seven Hundred
- 30 Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$720,000.00) as provided in subparagraphs
- 31 (i), (ii), (iii), (iv), (v), (vi), (vii), (viii), (ix), (x) * * * $\underline{}$
- 32 (xi) and (xii) of this paragraph, and such amount shall be divided
- 33 as follows: an amount of not more than Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 34 (\$50,000.00) per fire truck for the first six (6) trucks and not
- 35 more than Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) per fire truck for
- 36 the seventh, eighth, ninth, tenth * * $\star_{\underline{I}}$ eleventh and twelfth
- 37 trucks. Monies distributed under this chapter shall be expended

- 38 only for the purchase of new fire trucks and such trucks must meet
- 39 the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards in the
- 40 1900 series.
- 41 (i) Any county that has not applied for a fire
- 42 truck under this section is eligible to submit applications
- 43 for * * * twelve (12) fire trucks as follows: six (6) fire trucks
- 44 at not more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per truck
- 45 and * * * six (6) fire trucks at not more than Seventy Thousand
- 46 Dollars (\$70,000.00) per truck or a total of * * * Seven Hundred
- 47 Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$720,000.00).
- 48 (ii) Any county that has received one (1) fire
- 49 truck under this section is eligible to submit applications
- 50 for * * * eleven (11) fire trucks as follows: six (6) fire trucks
- 51 at not more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per truck
- 52 and * * * six (6) fire trucks at not more than Seventy Thousand
- 53 Dollars (\$70,000.00) per truck or a total of * * * Six Hundred
- 54 Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$670,000.00).
- 55 (iii) Any county that has received two (2) fire
- 56 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application
- 57 for * * * ten (10) fire trucks as follows: four (4) fire trucks
- 58 at not more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per truck
- 59 and * * * six (6) fire trucks at not more than Seventy Thousand
- 60 Dollars (\$70,000.00) per truck or a total of not more than * * *
- 61 Six Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$620,000.00).

- 62 (iv) Any county that has received three (3) fire
- 63 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application
- 64 for * * * nine (9) fire trucks as follows: three (3) fire trucks
- 65 at not more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per truck
- 66 and * * * six (6) fire trucks at not more than Seventy Thousand
- 67 Dollars (\$70,000.00) per truck or a total of not more than * * *
- 68 Five Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$570,000.00).
- 69 (v) Any county that has received four (4) fire
- 70 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application
- 71 for * * * eight (8) fire trucks as follows: two (2) fire trucks
- 72 at not more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per truck
- 73 and * * * six (6) fire trucks at not more than Seventy Thousand
- 74 Dollars (\$70,000.00) per truck or a total of not more than * * *
- 75 Five Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$520,000.00).
- 76 (vi) Any county that has received five (5) fire
- 77 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application
- 78 for * * * seven (7) fire trucks as follows: one (1) fire truck at
- 79 not more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per truck
- 80 and * * * six (6) fire trucks at not more than Seventy Thousand
- 81 Dollars (\$70,000.00) per truck or a total of not more than * * *
- 82 Four Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$470,000.00).
- 83 (vii) Any county that has received six (6) fire
- 84 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application
- 85 for * * * six (6) fire trucks at not more than Seventy Thousand

- 86 Dollars (\$70,000.00) per truck or a total of not more than * * *
- Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$420,000.00).
- 88 (viii) Any county that has received seven (7) fire
- 89 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application
- 90 for * * * five (5) fire trucks at not more than * * * Three
- 91 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00).
- 92 (ix) Any county that has received eight (8) fire
- 93 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application
- 94 for * * * four (4) fire trucks at not more than * * * Two Hundred
- 95 Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$280,000.00).
- 96 (x) Any county that has received nine (9) fire
- 97 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application
- 98 for * * * three (3) fire trucks at not more than * * * Two Hundred
- 99 Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000.00).
- 100 (xi) Any county that has received ten (10) fire
- 101 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application
- 102 for * * * two (2) fire trucks at not more than * * * One Hundred
- 103 Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000.00).
- 104 (xi) Any county that has received eleven (11) fire
- 105 trucks under this section is eligible to submit an application for
- 106 one (1) fire truck at not more than Seventy Thousand Dollars
- 107 (\$70,000.00).
- 108 (b) The board of supervisors of the county shall submit
- 109 its request for the receipt of monies to the Department of
- 110 Insurance. A committee composed of the Commissioner of Insurance,

- 111 the State Fire Coordinator, the Director of the Rating Bureau and
- 112 the Director of the State Fire Academy shall review the requests
- 113 by the boards of supervisors and shall determine whether the
- 114 county or municipality for which the board of supervisors has
- 115 requested a truck meets the requirements of eligibility under this
- 116 chapter.
- 117 (c) To be eligible to receive monies under this
- 118 chapter:
- 119 (i) A county or municipality must pledge to set
- 120 aside or dedicate each year as matching funds, for a period not to
- 121 extend over ten (10) years, local funds in an amount equal to or
- 122 not less than one-tenth (1/10) of the amount of monies for which
- 123 it is requesting distribution from the Rural Fire Truck Fund,
- 124 which pledged monies may be derived from local ad valorem tax
- 125 authorized by law or from any other funds available to the county
- 126 or municipality, except for those funds received by municipalities
- 127 or counties from the Municipal Fire Protection Fund or the County
- 128 Volunteer Fire Department Fund, as defined in Sections 83-1-37 and
- 129 83-1-39.
- 130 (ii) A municipality must provide adequate
- 131 documentation of its contract with the county that requires the
- 132 municipality to provide fire protection in rural areas. The term
- 133 "rural areas" means any area within the county located outside the
- 134 boundaries of an incorporated municipality or any incorporated

135	municipality with a population of two thousand five hundred
136	(2,500) or less.
137	(d) The Department of Insurance shall maintain an
138	accurate record of all monies distributed to counties and
139	municipalities and the number of fire trucks purchased and the
140	cost for each fire truck, such records to be kept separate from
141	other records of the Department of Insurance; notify counties and
142	municipalities of the Rural Fire Truck Acquisition Assistance
143	Program and the requirements for them to become eligible to
144	participate; adopt and promulgate such rules and regulations as
145	may be necessary and desirable to implement the provisions of this
146	chapter; and file with the Legislature a report detailing how
147	monies made available under this chapter were distributed and
148	spent during the preceding portion of the fiscal year in each
149	county and municipality, the number of fire trucks purchased, the
150	counties and municipalities making such purchases, * * * the cost
151	of each fire truck purchased and the equipment/gear purchased
152	under paragraph (e) of this subsection.
153	(e) Any county participating in any round under this
154	section may request and receive an amount up to Twenty Five
155	Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) for firefighting equipment and/or
156	personal protective equipment and related gear.
