AMENDMENT PROPOSED TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1

AMEND after line <sup>199</sup> ~~1200~~ by inserting the following new subsection:

(h) On or before August 15, 2019, and each succeeding month thereafter, twenty-five percent (25%) of the total use tax revenue collected during the preceding month under the provisions of this article shall be deposited into the Teacher and Assistant Teacher Supplemental Salary Fund created in Section of this act.

AMEND FURTHER by inserting the following new section after line 1274 (<sup>OR</sup> AS AMENDED)

SECTION 15. A special fund, to be designated as the "Teacher and Assistant Teacher Supplemental Salary Fund", is created within the State Treasury. The fund shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as a separate and special fund, separate and apart from the General Fund of the state. The fund shall consist of monies deposited therein under Section 27-67-31(h) and monies from any other source designated for deposit into such fund. Monies in the fund shall be expended by the State Board of Education to provide Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars

(\$2,500.00) as an annual supplement to each public school teacher licensed or authorized to teach in a public school by the State Board of Education, and each public school assistant teacher authorized by the State Board of Education to assist pupils in actual instruction under the supervision of a licensed teacher. This supplement shall be in addition to any other supplement or salary authorized by law to compensate teachers. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund.
