HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 75

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, AND THE INTRODUCTION,
3 CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE, OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT TO REQUIRE
4 EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THIS STATE TO WEAR BODY CAMERAS AT
5 ALL TIMES WHILE ON DUTY AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER; TO REQUIRE
6 EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE TO HAVE CAMERAS FOR THE PURPOSES OF
7 RECORDING ALL INTERACTIONS OF LAW ENFORCEMENT WITH NON-LAW
8 ENFORCEMENT; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY
9 THAT FAILS TO PROVIDE SUCH BODY OR VEHICLE CAMERAS; TO REQUIRE
10 THAT SUCH BODY OR VEHICLE CAMERAS REMAIN ON AND OPERATIONAL DURING
11 ALL TIMES AN OFFICER IS ON DUTY AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER; TO
12 PROHIBIT INTERRUPTION OF VIDEO FOOTAGE OF BODY AND VEHICLE
13 CAMERAS; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE OFFICER AND THE LAW
14 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR SUCH VIOLATIONS; TO CREATE A REBUTTABLE
15 PRESUMPTION OF THE CRIME OF MURDER, MANSLAUGHTER OR AGGRAVATED
16 ASSAULT BY LAW ENFORCEMENT WHEN A PERSON IS KILLED BY LAW
17 ENFORCEMENT, DIES AS A RESULT OF ACTIONS OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OR IS
18 SEVERELY INJURED AS A RESULT OF ACTIONS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT; TO
19 CREATE ENHANCED PENALTIES FOR SUCH ACTIONS IF SUCH ACTIONS ARE
20 MOTIVATED BY RACE; TO DESCRIBE HOW VIDEO FROM THE CAMERAS MUST BE
21 RETAINED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES; TO AUTHORIZE WHO MAY OBTAIN
22 A COPY OF A RECORDING; TO PROVIDE REMEDIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS
23 ACT; TO REQUIRE ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO PROVIDE RACIAL-
24 BIAS TRAINING; TO REQUIRE EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY TO HAVE AN
25 ONLINE LAW ENFORCEMENT MISCONDUCT REGISTRY; TO REQUIRE SUCH
26 REGISTRY TO BE FREE, PUBLIC AND EASILY ACCESSIBLE TO ANY PERSON;
27 TO REQUIRE THE REGISTRY TO LIST ALL COMPLAINTS OR ACTS OF
28 MISCONDUCT IN AN ITEMIZED FASHION LISTING WITH THE NAME OF EACH
29 OFFICER AND THE COMPLAINTS AND ACTS ATTACHED; TO AMEND SECTIONS
30 99-19-301, 99-19-303, 99-19-305 AND 99-19-307, TO CLARIFY THAT
31 CRIMES COMMITTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGAINST ANY PERSON BASED ON
32 RACE, COLOR, ANCESTRY, ETHNICITY, RELIGION, NATIONAL ORIGIN,
33 GENDER, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY OR DISABILITY; AND FOR
34 RELATED PURPOSES."



35 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE
36 OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That all of the
37 deadlines and other provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40 are
38 suspended for the purpose of requesting the drafting and the
39 introduction, consideration and passage, of a bill entitled "AN
40 ACT TO REQUIRE EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THIS STATE TO WEAR
41 BODY CAMERAS AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON DUTY AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT
42 OFFICER; TO REQUIRE EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE TO HAVE CAMERAS
43 FOR THE PURPOSES OF RECORDING ALL INTERACTIONS OF LAW ENFORCEMENT
44 WITH NON-LAW ENFORCEMENT; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR ANY LAW
45 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT FAILS TO PROVIDE SUCH BODY OR VEHICLE
46 CAMERAS; TO REQUIRE THAT SUCH BODY OR VEHICLE CAMERAS REMAIN ON
47 AND OPERATIONAL DURING ALL TIMES AN OFFICER IS ON DUTY AS A LAW
48 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER; TO PROHIBIT INTERRUPTION OF VIDEO FOOTAGE OF
49 BODY AND VEHICLE CAMERAS; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE OFFICER AND
50 THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR SUCH VIOLATIONS; TO CREATE A
51 REBUTTABLE PRESUMPTION OF THE CRIME OF MURDER, MANSLAUGHTER OR
52 AGGRAVATED ASSAULT BY LAW ENFORCEMENT WHEN A PERSON IS KILLED BY
53 LAW ENFORCEMENT, DIES AS A RESULT OF ACTIONS OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OR
54 IS SEVERELY INJURED AS A RESULT OF ACTIONS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT; TO
55 CREATE ENHANCED PENALTIES FOR SUCH ACTIONS IF SUCH ACTIONS ARE
56 MOTIVATED BY RACE; TO DESCRIBE HOW VIDEO FROM THE CAMERAS MUST BE
57 RETAINED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES; TO AUTHORIZE WHO MAY OBTAIN
58 A COPY OF A RECORDING; TO PROVIDE REMEDIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS
59 ACT; TO REQUIRE ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO PROVIDE RACIAL-



60 BIAS TRAINING; TO REQUIRE EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY TO HAVE AN
61 ONLINE LAW ENFORCEMENT MISCONDUCT REGISTRY; TO REQUIRE SUCH
62 REGISTRY TO BE FREE, PUBLIC AND EASILY ACCESSIBLE TO ANY PERSON;
63 TO REQUIRE THE REGISTRY TO LIST ALL COMPLAINTS OR ACTS OF
64 MISCONDUCT IN AN ITEMIZED FASHION LISTING WITH THE NAME OF EACH
65 OFFICER AND THE COMPLAINTS AND ACTS ATTACHED; TO AMEND SECTIONS
66 99-19-301, 99-19-303, 99-19-305 AND 99-19-307, TO CLARIFY THAT
67 CRIMES COMMITTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGAINST ANY PERSON BASED ON
68 RACE, COLOR, ANCESTRY, ETHNICITY, RELIGION, NATIONAL ORIGIN,
69 GENDER, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY OR DISABILITY; AND FOR
70 RELATED PURPOSES."
