13        SECTION        (1) The State Department of Health, in  
14 cooperation with the Department of Archives and History and the  
15 Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management and  
16 subject to funds being made available, shall design and cause to  
17 be constructed and maintained on state-owned lands at some  
18 suitable and appropriate place in or near the City of Jackson, an  
19 Emergency Medical Services Memorial to honor those Emergency  
20 Medical Services personnel who have given their lives in the  
21 performance of their official duties and those who have made a  
22 dramatic impact on or substantial contribution to emergency
