## HOUSE BILL NO. 38

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE RESIDENTS OF CERTAIN LONG-TERM CARE 2 FACILITIES WHO ARE SIXTY YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER TO OBTAIN A PRENEED 3 CONTRACT THAT PROVIDES SERVICES, MERCHANDISE OR BOTH IN CONNECTION WITH THE FINAL DISPOSITION OF THE RESIDENT'S BODY AFTER HIS OR HER DEATH, WITHIN SIX MONTHS AFTER BEING ADMITTED TO THE FACILITY; TO 5 6 REQUIRE RESIDENTS OF THOSE FACILITIES ON JULY 1, 2024, WHO DO NOT 7 HAVE A PRENEED CONTRACT TO OBTAIN A PRENEED CONTRACT NOT LATER THAN DECEMBER 31, 2024; TO PROHIBIT FACILITIES FROM REFUSING TO 8 9 ADMIT PERSONS OR TAKING ADVERSE ACTIONS AGAINST RESIDENTS BECAUSE 10 THEY DO NOT HAVE A PRENEED CONTRACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 **SECTION 1.** (1) Each resident of a nursing facility, assisted living facility, personal care home or adult foster care 13 facility licensed under Chapter 11, Title 43, Mississippi Code of 14 15 1972, who is sixty (60) years of age or older shall obtain a 16 preneed contract meeting the requirements of the Preneed Cemetery 17 and Funeral Registration Act (Sections 75-63-51 through 75-63-81) which provides services, merchandise or both in connection with 18 19 the final disposition of the resident's body after his or her 20 death, within six (6) months after being admitted to the facility. 21 If a resident does not obtain a preneed contract within the time 22 required by this section, the facility must purchase a preneed H. - 23 contract for the resident and add the cost of purchasing the
- 24 preneed contract to the regular charges to the resident by the
- 25 facility.
- 26 (2) Any resident of a facility described in subsection (1)
- 27 of this section on July 1, 2024, who is sixty (60) years of age or
- 28 older, who was admitted to the facility before July 1, 2024, and
- 29 who does not have a preneed contract meeting the requirements of
- 30 this section must obtain a preneed contract not later than
- 31 December 31, 2024, or the facility shall purchase a preneed
- 32 contract for the resident as provided in this section.
- 33 (3) A nursing facility, assisted living facility, personal
- 34 care home or adult foster care facility may not refuse to admit a
- 35 person to the facility because the person does not have a preneed
- 36 contract before becoming a resident of the facility and may not
- 37 take any adverse action against a resident of a facility because
- 38 the person does not obtain a preneed contract while a resident of
- 39 the facility. The State Department of Health shall enforce the
- 40 provisions of this subsection.
- 41 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after July 1, 2024.
