HOUSE BILL NO. 44

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-125-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
 TO PROVIDE THAT PHYSICAL THERAPISTS DO NOT NEED TO HAVE PRIOR WORK
 EXPERIENCE IN ORDER TO WORK AT A PRESCRIBED PEDIATRIC EXTENDED
 CARE CENTER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 41-125-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 41-125-19. (1) To carry out the intention of the
- 9 Legislature to provide safe and sanitary facilities and healthful
- 10 programs, the licensing agency shall adopt and publish rules to
- 11 implement the provisions of this chapter, which shall include
- 12 reasonable and fair standards. Any conflict between these
- 13 standards and those that may be set forth in local, county or city
- 14 ordinances shall be resolved in favor of those having statewide
- 15 effect. Those standards shall relate to:
- 16 (a) The assurance that PPEC services are family
- 17 centered and provide individualized medical, developmental and
- 18 family training services.

19 (b)	The maintenance	of PPEC	centers.	based	upon th	ıe
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- 20 size of the structure and number of children, relating to
- 21 plumbing, heating, lighting, ventilation and other building
- 22 conditions, including adequate space, which will ensure the
- 23 health, safety, comfort and protection from fire of the children
- 24 served.
- 25 (c) The appropriate provisions of the most recent
- 26 edition of the "Life Safety Code" shall be applied.
- 27 (d) The number and qualifications of all personnel who
- 28 have responsibility for the care of the children served.
- 29 (e) All sanitary conditions within the PPEC center and
- 30 its surroundings, including water supply, sewage disposal, food
- 31 handling and general hygiene, and maintenance thereof, which will
- 32 ensure the health and comfort of children served.
- 33 (f) Programs and basic services promoting and
- 34 maintaining the health and development of the children served and
- 35 meeting the training needs of the children's parents or legal
- 36 quardians.
- 37 (g) Supportive, contracted, other operational and
- 38 transportation services. However, the licensing agency may not
- 39 require physical therapists to have prior work experience in order
- 40 to work at a PPEC center.
- 41 (h) Maintenance of appropriate medical records, data
- 42 and information relative to the children and programs. Those

- 45 (2) The licensing agency shall adopt rules to ensure that:
- 46 (a) No child attends a PPEC center for more than twelve
- 47 (12) hours within a twenty-four-hour period.
- 48 (b) No PPEC center provides services other than those
- 49 provided to medically or technologically dependent children.
- 50 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 51 and after July 1, 2024.
