## HOUSE BILL NO. 174

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) This section shall be known as the "No Fees
- 8 for EFTs Act."
- 9 (2) As used in this section, the following terms shall be
- 10 defined as provided in this subsection:
- 11 (a) "Health care provider" has the meaning as defined
- 12 in 42 USC Section 1320d(3).
- 13 (b) "Health plan" has the meaning as defined in 42 USC
- 14 Section 1320d(5).
- 15 (3) A health plan doing business in this state or doing
- 16 business with a health care provider in this state, or any entity
- 17 completing the transaction on behalf of the health plan, shall not
- 18 impose any charge, fee or other payment (including through a
- 19 withhold from payment) on a health care provider for electronic

- 20 fund transfers and health care payment and remittance advice
- 21 transactions made on or after July 1, 2024.
- 22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2024.
