HOUSE BILL NO. 249

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO INCLUDE INSTRUCTION IN 2 MENTAL ILLNESS AND MENTAL HEALTH IN THE HEALTH EDUCATION COMPONENT 3 OF THE COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAM; TO DESCRIBE 4 THE OBJECTIVES OF THE MENTAL HEALTH INSTRUCTION; TO REQUIRE 5 IN-SERVICE TRAINING ON MENTAL ILLNESS FOR LICENSED SCHOOL 6 EMPLOYEES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. (1) Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, 9 the health education component of the Comprehensive School Health 10 Education Program must include instruction in mental illness and 11 mental health. The Office of Comprehensive School Health 12 Education shall identify the elementary grade level that is most 13 appropriate for incorporating the mental illness and mental health instruction into health education and shall require 14 15 age-appropriate mental illness and mental health instruction to be included in the curriculum for that grade and all higher grade 16 levels. The mental illness and mental health instruction must be 17 18 taught during the minimum instructional time required under 19 Section 37-13-134(1) to be dedicated to health education 20 instruction.

 include, at a minimum, the following objectives for students:

(a) Understanding mental health problems and gaining an
 awareness of the myths and realities of mental illness;

(b) Destigmatizing mental illness and improving
attitudes toward seeking help for mental health problems;

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(c) Recognizing signs and symptoms of mental illness;(d) Employing positive coping techniques to addressstress that does not rise to a level requiring professional

30 treatment but if left unattended, may lead to mental illness; and 31 (e) Utilizing professional resources available to 32 students to address mental health issues affecting a student or 33 member of a student's family, including telephone numbers of 34 assistance hotlines and Internet websites of mental health 35 agencies that serve the region in which a school is located.

36 (3) The State Department of Education shall require each 37 local school district to conduct in-service training on mental illness for all licensed school district employees. 38 The 39 department, in conjunction with the State Department of Mental 40 Health, shall develop the content and materials for the training 41 which, at a minimum, must include recognizing signs and symptoms 42 of mental illness in students.

43 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 44 and after July 1, 2024.
