HOUSE BILL NO. 310

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-21-69, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,  
2 TO REVISE THE NUMBER OF DAYS BY WHICH THE NEW OWNER OF THE VEHICLE  
3 HAS TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR ISSUANCE OF PRIVILEGE LICENSE TAG FROM  
4 SEVEN TO THIRTY WORKING DAYS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-21-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
7 amended as follows:

8 63-21-69. When a vehicle subject to titling under this  
9 chapter is acquired from a dealer or another person by sale or  
10 otherwise, the new owner of the vehicle shall have \* \* \* thirty  
11 (30) full working days, exclusive of the date of delivery, within  
12 which to make application for the required privilege license tag.

13 No privilege license tag shall be issued by any tax collector  
14 or the State Tax Commission if the vehicle is subject to titling  
15 under this chapter unless the vehicle owner makes an application  
16 therefor and shall thereupon tender his application for  
17 certificate of title with the application for a privilege license.  
18 If, however, the vehicle owner already has a certificate of title,  
19 then the original certificate or, if his original certificate be



20 in the hands of a lienholder, then his duplicate certificate or  
21 other official document as prescribed by the State Tax Commission  
22 shall be tendered to the tax collector or the State Tax  
23 Commission. The tax collector or the State Tax Commission, as the  
24 case may be, shall thereupon enter the number of the application  
25 or certificate on the privilege license application and on the  
26 privilege license receipt.

27 The provisions and requirements of this section implement the  
28 provisions and requirements of Section 27-19-59 and Section  
29 27-19-61. Nothing contained in this section or in this chapter  
30 shall in any way amend or supersede any of the existing statutes  
31 of this state or any of the provisions or requirements of such  
32 statutes with respect to the registration of vehicles and making  
33 applications for privilege licenses for vehicles. However, the  
34 State Tax Commission shall by suitable rules and regulations  
35 provide for the implementation of the requirements of this section  
36 and this chapter with the requirements of existing statutes with  
37 respect to the registration of vehicles and with respect to  
38 obtaining privilege licenses therefor.

39 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
40 and after July 1, 2024.
