HOUSE BILL NO. 337

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 63-1-35 AND 45-35-3, MISSISSIPPI 2 CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE ALL DRIVER'S LICENSES, DRIVING PERMITS, 3 COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSES OR IDENTIFICATION CARDS ISSUED BY THE 4 STATE OF MISSISSIPPI TO INCLUDE THE WORDS "CRISIS LIFELINE - DIAL 5 OR TEXT 988, OR CHAT 988LIFELINE.ORG" ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF THE 6 LICENSE, PERMIT OR CARD; TO AMEND SECTIONS 45-35-11 AND 45-35-53, 7 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY TO THE PRECEDING PROVISIONS; TO REQUIRE ALL STATE-SUPPORTED POSTSECONDARY 8 9 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS UNDER THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE 10 BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING, 11 MISSISSIPPI COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OR BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF A 12 COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT TO ISSUE AN IDENTIFICATION CARD TO ALL 13 PERSONNEL EMPLOYED BY AND ALL STUDENTS ENROLLED AND ATTENDING SAID POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTIONS TO INCLUDE THE WORDS "CRISIS LIFELINE -14 DIAL OR TEXT 988, OR CHAT 988LIFELINE.ORG" ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF 15 16 THE LICENSE, PERMIT OR CARD; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 17

18 SECTION 1. Section 63-1-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

19 amended as follows:

20 63-1-35. (1) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall

prescribe the form of license issued pursuant to this article 21

which shall, among other features, include a driver's license 22

23 number assigned by the Department of Public Safety. A licensee

26 license number for purposes of identification. Additionally, each 27 license shall bear a full-face color photograph of the licensee in such form that the license and the photograph cannot be separated. 28 29 The photograph shall be taken so that one (1) exposure will 30 photograph the applicant and the application simultaneously on the 31 same film. The department shall use a process in the issuance of a license with a color photograph that shall prevent as nearly as 32 possible any alteration, counterfeiting, duplication, 33 34 reproduction, forging or modification of the license or the 35 superimposition of a photograph without ready detection. The 36 photograph shall be replaced by the department at the time of 37 Drivers' licenses, including photographs appearing renewal. 38 thereon, may be renewed by electronic means according to rules and regulations promulgated by the commissioner in conformity to 39 Section 27-104-33. 40

41 (2)The commissioner shall prescribe the form of license 42 issued pursuant to this article to licensees who are not United States citizens and who do not possess a social security number 43 44 issued by the United States government. The license of such 45 persons shall include a number and/or other identifying features. 46 (3) Any new, renewal or duplicate driver's license, 47 temporary driving permit or commercial driver's license issued to a person required to register as a sex offender pursuant to 48 49 Section 45-33-25 shall bear a designation identifying the licensee or permittee as a sex offender. 50

The veteran requesting the 57 "Vet" designation shall present his DD-214, Military Retiree 58 Identification Card, United States Department of Veterans Affairs 59 Medical Identification Card, United States Department of Veterans Affairs Identification Card or National Guard Form NGB 22. 60 The veteran requesting the "Vet" designation may present his DD-214, 61 Military Retiree Identification Card, United States Department of 62 63 Veterans Affairs Medical Identification Card, United States Department of Veterans Affairs Identification Card or National 64 65 Guard Form NGB 22 in person at the Mississippi Department of 66 Public Safety Driver's License Station.

(5) Not later than July 1, 2021, the commissioner shall develop and implement a driver's license or driving permit in electronic format as an additional option for license or permit holders. Acceptable electronic formats include display of electronic images on a cellular phone or any other type of electronic device.

(6) If false documents are provided by an individual for purposes of obtaining a veteran driver's license, such action shall be considered fraudulent use of identity under Section

79 (7) Any license issued under the authority of this article, 80 whether a new, renewal or duplicate license, temporary driving 81 permit, temporary or regular learner's permit, commercial driver's 82 license or identification card, and whether in physical or 83 electronic format, shall include the words, "Crisis Lifeline -84 Dial or text 988, or chat 988lifeline.org" on the reverse side of 85 the license, permit or identification card.

86 SECTION 2. Section 45-35-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 87 amended as follows:

45-35-3. (1) Any person six (6) years of age or older may be issued an identification card by the department which is certified by the registrant and attested by the commissioner as to true name, correct age and such other identifying data as required by Section 45-35-5.

93 (2) The new, renewal or duplicate identification card of a 94 person required to register as a sex offender pursuant to Section 95 45-33-25 shall bear a designation identifying the cardholder as a 96 sex offender.

97 (3) The commissioner is authorized to provide the new,
98 renewal or duplicate identification card to any honorably
99 discharged veteran as defined in Title 38 of the United States
100 Code, and such identification card shall exhibit the letters "Vet"

The 102 veteran requesting the "Vet" designation shall present his DD-214 103 or equivalent document that includes a notation from the State 104 Veterans Affairs Board that the applicant is a veteran.

105 (4) Not later than July 1, 2021, the commissioner shall 106 develop and implement an identification card in electronic format 107 as an additional option for card holders. Acceptable electronic 108 formats include display of electronic images on a cellular phone 109 or any other type of electronic device.

110 (5) Any identification card issued under the authority of 111 this article, whether physical or in electronic format, shall 112 include the words, "Crisis Lifeline - Dial or text 988, or chat 113 9881ifeline.org" on the reverse side of the identification card.

SECTION 3. Section 45-35-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

116 45-35-11. All identification cards shall be centrally issued 117 by the department, adequately describe the registrant, bear a 118 color photograph of the registrant, and include other such 119 identifying data as required by Section 45-35-5, and shall comply

120 with all additional reference and resource information

121 requirements specified in Section 45-35-3.

122 SECTION 4. Section 45-35-53, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 123 amended as follows:

45-35-53. (1) The Department of Public Safety shall issue

150 (2)The identification card for persons with disabilities 151 shall bear an identification card number which shall not be the 152 same as the applicant's social security number. The commissioner 153 shall prescribe the form of identification cards issued pursuant 154 to this article to persons who are not United States citizens. 155 The identification cards of such persons shall include a number 156 and any other identifying information prescribed by the 157 commissioner.

158 SECTION 5. All personnel employed by and all students 159 enrolled and attending state-supported postsecondary educational 160 institutions under the governing purview of the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, the Mississippi 161 162 Community College Board and the board of trustees of a community college district, as prescribed in Chapter 101, Title 37, 163 Mississippi Code of 1972, and Chapter 69, Title 37, Mississippi 164 Code of 1972, respectively, shall be issued a identification card 165 166 to be worn or kept on their person at all times while on campus property. Any identification card issued under the authority of 167 168 this section, whether physical or in an electronic format, shall include the words, "Crisis Lifeline - Dial or text 988, or chat 169 170 988lifeline.org".

171 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 172 and after July 1, 2024.
