HOUSE BILL NO. 1179

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-181-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 WHICH IS THE DEFINITIONS SECTION OF THE "EQUAL OPPORTUNITY FOR 3 STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS ACT," TO REVISE THE DEFINITIONS FOR "ELIGIBLE STUDENT" AND "ELIGIBLE SCHOOL" TO REFLECT THE INCLUSION 4 5 OF STUDENTS DIAGNOSED WITH DYSLEXIA WHO DO NOT RECEIVE THE 6 ASSISTANCE OF A MISSISSIPPI DYSLEXIA THERAPY SCHOLARSHIP FOR 7 STUDENTS WITH DYSLEXIA PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. Section 37-181-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 amended as follows: 11 37-181-3. The terms used in this chapter shall have the meanings ascribed herein, unless the context clearly indicates 12 13 otherwise: 14 (a) "ESA program" means the Education Scholarship Account (ESA) program created in this chapter. 15 16 (b) "Eligible student" means any student who has had an 17 active Individualized Education Program (IEP) within the past 18 three (3) years and has maintained eligibility or who has been 19 properly screened and has received a diagnosis of dyslexia and is 20 not a recipient of a scholarship under the Mississippi Dyslexia H. 21 <u>Therapy Scholarship for Students with Dyslexia Program, which may</u> 22 <u>serve as a determination of eligibility in lieu of an IEP or any</u> 23 other requirements.

(c) "Participating student" means any student who meets
the qualifications of an eligible student as defined in paragraph
(b) of this section and is participating in an ESA program at an
eligible school.

(d) "Parent" means a resident of this state who is a
parent, legal guardian, custodian or other person with the
authority to act on behalf of the eligible student.

31 (e) "Department" means the State Department of32 Education.

33 (f) "Home school district" means the public school34 district in which the student resides.

"Eligible school" means a state-accredited special 35 (a) 36 purpose school, a state-accredited nonpublic school, or a 37 nonpublic school located in the state that has enrolled a participating student and is providing services for the 38 39 participating student's disability or special education needs, or 40 is providing services addressing a participating student's IEP. 41 For purposes of eligible students with a dyslexia diagnosis, an 42 eligible school includes those defined in Section 37-173-1(g) and 43 any public school or university-based program capable of providing intensive full day instruction to such eligible students. 44 An

(h) "Tutor" means a person who is certified or licensed by a state, regional, or national certification, licensing, or accreditation organization or who has earned a valid teacher's license or who has experience teaching at an eligible postsecondary institution.

(i) "Postsecondary institution" means a community
college, college, or university accredited by a state, regional or
national accrediting organization.

(j) "Educational service provider" means an eligible
school, tutor, or other person or organization that provides
education-related services and products to participating students.

(k) "Awarded ESA school year" means the duration of the
school year in which ESA program funds are deposited in a
student's ESA.

(1) Nothing in this section shall negate federal law
requiring public school districts to identify and provide services
to students with disabilities who live within the public school
district, including those enrolled in nonpublic schools or home
instruction programs.

(m) An eligible school shall provide notice to a
participating student's home school district when the eligible
student enrolls in the eligible school with an ESA. Furthermore,
a public school district providing special education services to a

No. 1179 24/HR43/R581 PAGE 3 (DJ\EW) 70 participating student enrolled in an eligible school shall be 71 reimbursed by the eligible school, or parent or guardian who 72 submitted the ESA application, fair market value for any special 73 education services rendered to the eligible student in an amount 74 not to exceed the amount of ESA funds reimbursed to the eligible 75 student during the awarded ESA school year.

76 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 77 and after July 1, 2024.
