- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-15-403, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
 TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF THE TERM "FIRST RESPONDERS" TO INCLUDE
 COUNTY ROAD CREW EMPLOYEES UNDER THE MISSISSIPPI FIRST RESPONDERS
 HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 25-15-403, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 25-15-403. For purposes of this article, the following words
- 9 shall have the following meanings unless the context clearly
- 10 indicates otherwise:
- 11 (a) "Cancer" means a disease caused by an uncontrolled
- 12 division of abnormal cells in a part of the body or a malignant
- 13 growth or tumor resulting from the division of abnormal cells.
- 14 "Cancer" is limited to cancer affecting the bladder, brain, colon,
- 15 liver, pancreas, skin, kidney, gastrointestinal tract,

- 16 reproductive tract, leukemia, lymphoma, multiple myeloma,
- 17 prostate, testicles and breast.
- 18 (b) "Firefighter" means any firefighter who has ten
- 19 (10) or more years of service and is employed by the State of

- 21 duty status, and any firefighter who has ten (10) or more years of
- 22 service and is registered with the State of Mississippi, or a
- 23 political subdivision thereof, on a volunteer firefighting status.
- 24 (c) "Law enforcement officer" means any officer who has
- 25 been certified by the Mississippi Board on Law Enforcement Officer
- 26 Standards and Training and has ten (10) or more years of service.
- 27 (d) "County road crew employee" means any individual
- 28 who works for a county road department on a full time basis and is
- 29 responsible for keeping roads and bridges cleared and open when
- 30 disaster strikes.
- 31 (* * *e) "First responder" means any firefighter and
- 32 law enforcement officer as defined in paragraphs (b) \star \star , (c)
- 33 and (d) of this section.
- 34 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force form
- 35 and after July 1, 2024.
