HOUSE BILL NO. 1270

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-19-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF CERTAIN REGIONAL MENTAL HEALTH 3 COMMISSIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 41-19-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 6 7 41-19-35. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) and (3), except as otherwise provided in this section, the 8 9 board of supervisors of each participating county in the program shall appoint one (1) member to represent its county on the 10 11 regional commission in its respective region for a term of four (4) years who shall serve at the will and pleasure of the 12 appointing board of supervisors, who may be a clerk, sheriff or 13 14 deputy. In addition, the chancery clerks of the counties in each region shall select a chancery clerk or a deputy clerk to serve as 15 16 a nonvoting liaison to the commission, and the sheriffs of the counties in each region shall select a sheriff or a deputy sheriff 17 18 to serve as a nonvoting liaison to the commission. Any

19 compensation of such members shall be paid by the regional 20 commission, in its discretion, from any funds available. Each 21 member of the commission shall attend the orientation training for 22 new commissioners and the annual training for all commissioners 23 held by the Department of Mental Health. The Department of Mental 24 Health shall notify the board of supervisors when a commissioner 25 does not attend either the orientation training or annual 26 training. Upon notice from the Department of Mental Health that a 27 commissioner has failed to attend the required meetings, the 28 appointing board of supervisors shall remove the commissioner, 29 unless the department and the commission agree to an alternate 30 arrangement to allow the commissioner to continue to serve until 31 the next opportunity to attend the orientation meeting and/or the 32 annual training.

33 (2) Beginning on July 1, 2024, each regional commission 34 consisting of only two (2) counties that border the State of 35 Alabama shall be comprised of five (5) members. The board of supervisors of each participating county described in this 36 37 subsection shall appoint two (2) members to represent its 38 respective county on the commission, and an additional member 39 shall be appointed by the board of supervisors of the county 40 having the largest population according to the latest federal 41 decennial census. Appointees to the regional commission under 42 this subsection shall serve for a term of four (4) years. Any

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43 compensation of such members shall be paid by the regional 44 commission, in its discretion, from any available funds. (3) Beginning on July 1, 2024, each regional commission 45 46 consisting of only one (1) county that borders the State of Alabama shall be comprised of up to five (5) members. The board 47 48 of supervisors of the participating county described in this 49 subsection shall appoint members to the commission. Appointees to 50 the regional commission under this subsection shall serve for a 51 term of four (4) years. Any compensation of such members shall be 52 paid by the regional commission, in its discretion, from any 53 available funds. 54 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

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and after July 1, 2024.
