## HOUSE BILL NO. 4099

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO DUSTIN DARELL MILLS OF RANKIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Dustin Darell Mills of Rankin County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction for the crime of grand larceny, in Rankin County, for
- 8 which he was sentenced to serve five (5) years under the
- 9 supervision of the Mississippi Department of Corrections. He was
- 10 released on probation on November 13, 2009. On February 19, 2013,
- 11 he was convicted for the crime of grand larceny, burglary-vehicle
- 12 and burglary-nonresidential to serve five (5) years and one (1)
- 13 day in the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections,
- 14 the sentence to run concurrently with each other and consecutively
- 15 with another conviction.
- He was released on June 25, 2013, and discharged on July 1,
- 17 2015. The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted

- 18 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
- 19 lawful manner.
- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after its passage.
