- 6 SECTION 1. The American Quarter Horse, which is well-suited
- 7 for the intricate and quick maneuvers required for rodeo events,
- 8 is hereby designated the "Official State Horse of the State of
- 9 Mississippi."
- 10 **SECTION 2.** The Kemp's Ridley sea turtle, the most endangered
- 11 sea turtle in the world, which is native to Mississippi, is hereby
- 12 designated the "Official Sea Turtle of the State of Mississippi."

- 14 and after July 1, 2024.
