SENATE BILL NO. 2160

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-27-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
 2 PROVIDE THAT A LICENSED PODIATRIST MAY PERFORM SURGICAL TREATMENT
 3 OF THE ANKLE AND GOVERNING STRUCTURES AND TISSUE WHEN THE
 4 PODIATRIST HAS MET CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS; TO PROVIDE THAT A
 5 LICENSED PODIATRIST MAY PERFORM ANKLE SURGERY ONLY IN AN
 6 ACCREDITED HOSPITAL LICENSED IN THE STATE; TO SET CERTAIN
 7 LIMITATIONS ON THE PROCEDURES THAT A PODIATRIST MAY PERFORM; AND
 8 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

10 **SECTION 1.** Section 73-27-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
 11 amended as follows:

12 73-27-1. (1) The practice of podiatric medicine is that
 13 profession concerned with the prevention, examination, diagnosis
 14 and medical, surgical and adjuvant treatment of conditions of the
 15 human foot. For the purposes of this chapter, "foot" means that
 16 part of the human anatomy which consists of the tarsal bones,
 17 metatarsal bones and phalanges.

18 (2) A podiatrist is a medical care provider who engages in
 19 the practice of podiatric medicine.

20 (3) A podiatrist may prescribe and administer drugs and
 21 tests, excluding general and spinal anesthesia, that are essential



22 to the practice of podiatric medicine when used for or in
23 connection with treatment of disorders of the human foot.

24 (4) A podiatrist properly licensed in Mississippi may
25 perform surgical treatment of the ankle and governing structures
26 and tissue when that podiatrist meets the following requirements:

27 (a) The podiatrist has completed a post graduate
28 surgical residency program of at least twenty-four (24) months in
29 length that has been approved by the Council on Podiatric Medical
30 Education (CPME) and is currently eligible to become certified to
31 perform "Reconstructive Rearfoot and Ankle Surgery" (RRA) by the
32 American Board of Foot and Ankle Surgery (ABFAS); and

33 (b) The podiatrist is certified by the American Board
34 of Foot and Ankle Surgery (ABFAS) to perform "Reconstructive
35 Rearfoot and Ankle Surgery" (RRA).

36 (5) A licensed podiatrist may perform ankle surgery only in
37 an accredited hospital licensed in the state. The podiatrist
38 shall have received surgical privileges by the medical staff of
39 that facility to perform ankle surgery and other delineation of
40 privileges.

41 (6) A podiatrist's surgical treatment of the ankle is
42 limited to procedures listed by the Council of Podiatric Medical
43 Education (CPME) as found in CPME 320, and their successors, as
44 being required for graduation and certification in rearfoot and
45 ankle surgery.



46 (7) For purposes of this section, an accredited hospital is
47 one that is actively licensed in the state by the Department of
48 Health as an Acute Care Hospital with surgical services available.

49 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
50 and after July 1, 2024.
