## SENATE BILL NO. 2345

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-27-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REVISE THE DEFINITION OF PODIATRIC MEDICINE TO INCLUDE TREATMENT 3 OF THE FOOT AND ANKLE AND THEIR GOVERNING AND RELATED STRUCTURES; 4 TO REQUIRE THE BOARD OF MEDICAL LICENSURE TO PROMULGATE RULES 5 RELATED TO THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 73-27-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 9 73-27-1. (1) The practice of podiatric medicine is that 10 profession concerned with the prevention, examination, diagnosis and medical, surgical and adjuvant treatment of conditions of the 11 12 human foot and ankle, and their governing and related structures, including the muscles or tendons of the lower leg governing the 13 14 functions of the foot and ankle, including soft tissue up to the 15 tibial tubercle/tuberosity. \* \* \* 16 (2) For the purposes of this chapter, the following terms 17 shall have the meanings ascribed herein: (a) "Ankle" consists of the ankle joint which consists 18 19 of the distal third of the tibia and fibula and their G1/2 S. 20 articulations with the talus and the soft tissue structures 21 surrounding the foot and ankle. 22 "Board" means the Mississippi State Board of (b) 23 Medical Licensure. (c) "Physician" means any person with a valid doctor of 24 25 medicine, doctor of osteopathy or doctor of podiatric medicine. 26 ( \* \* \*3) A podiatrist is a \* \* \* physician who engages in 27 the practice of podiatric medicine. 28 ( \* \* \*4) A podiatrist may prescribe and administer drugs 29 and tests, excluding general and spinal anesthesia, that are 30 essential to the practice of podiatric medicine when used for or in connection with treatment of disorders of the human foot and 31 32 ankle, and their governing and related structures, including the muscles or tendons of the lower leg governing the functions of the 33 foot and ankle and soft tissue up to the tibial 34 35 tubercle/tuberosity. 36 A podiatrist properly licensed in this state may perform conservative and surgical treatments of the foot and ankle and 37 38 governing and related structures, including the muscles or tendons 39 of the lower leg governing the functions of the foot and ankle and 40 soft tissue up to the tibial tubercle/tuberosity, when that podiatrist has completed training determined to be sufficient by 41 42 the board at a program accredited by a nationally recognized 43 accrediting association acceptable by the board. Implementation 44 of the provisions of this subsection (4) shall be made pursuant to

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45 rules promulgated by the board, which are predicated on the

- 46 education or level of training, or both, of an applicant.
- 47 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 48 and after July 1, 2024.
