SENATE BILL NO. 2558

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-19-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE MENTAL HEALTH REGIONAL COMMISSIONS TO BE ESTABLISHED WITH A SET COMPOSITION OF MEMBERS IF EACH BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTIES PARTICIPATING IN A PARTICULAR REGIONAL COMMISSION AGREE TO SUCH COMPOSITION AS EVIDENCED BY RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED BY EACH BOARD; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8 SECTION 1. Section 41-19-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

9 amended as follows:

41-19-35. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 10 (2) of this section, the board of supervisors of each 11 12 participating county in the program shall appoint one (1) member 13 to represent its county on the regional commission in its respective region for a term of four (4) years who shall serve at 14 15 the will and pleasure of the appointing board of supervisors, who may be a clerk, sheriff or deputy. 16 (2) A regional commission may have a different composition 17

18 than provided in subsection (1) of this section if each board of

20 <u>commission agree to such composition as evidenced by resolutions</u>
21 <u>adopted by each board of supervisors.</u>

Each member shall represent his or her county on the regional commission in its respective region for a term of four (4) years and shall serve at the will and pleasure of their appointing board of supervisors.

In addition, the chancery clerks of the counties in each 26 (3) 27 region shall select a chancery clerk or a deputy clerk to serve as 28 a nonvoting liaison to the commission, and the sheriffs of the 29 counties in each region shall select a sheriff or a deputy sheriff 30 to serve as a nonvoting liaison to the commission. Any compensation of such members shall be paid by the regional 31 32 commission, in its discretion, from any funds available. Each 33 member of the commission shall attend the orientation training for new commissioners and the annual training for all commissioners 34 35 held by the Department of Mental Health. The Department of Mental 36 Health shall notify the board of supervisors when a commissioner 37 does not attend either the orientation training or annual 38 training. Upon notice from the Department of Mental Health that a 39 commissioner has failed to attend the required meetings, the 40 appointing board of supervisors shall remove the commissioner, 41 unless the department and the commission agree to an alternate arrangement to allow the commissioner to continue to serve until 42 43 the next opportunity to attend the orientation meeting and/or the 44 annual training.
