SENATE BILL NO. 2643

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE SEGMENT OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 8 THAT
2 EXTENDS THROUGH GRENADA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AS THE "WILLIAM
3 WINTER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY" IN MEMORY OF THE LATE FORMER GOVERNOR
4 WILLIAM FORREST WINTER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** (1) The section of Mississippi Highway 8 that
7 starts at Interstate 55 in Grenada County, Mississippi, and
8 extends east through Grenada County, Mississippi, is designated
9 and shall be known as the "William Winter Memorial Highway" in
10 memory of the late former Mississippi Governor, Lieutenant
11 Governor, State Treasurer and Representative in the Mississippi
12 House of Representatives, William Forrest Winter of Grenada,
13 Mississippi.

14 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
15 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
16 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
18 and after its passage.
