SENATE BILL NO. 2884

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE COVID-19 MRNA
2 VACCINATIONS UNTIL THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH ANALYZES ANY
3 EXISTING DATA AND CONCLUDES THAT THE BENEFITS OF SUCH VACCINE
4 OUTWEIGH THE RISKS; TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL
5 CONDUCT A STUDY AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE BENEFITS AND RISKS
6 OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF COVID-19 MRNA VACCINATION; AND FOR
7 RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 **SECTION 1.** (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law
10 to the contrary, the administration of the COVID-19 mRNA
11 vaccinations shall be prohibited until the State Department of
12 Health analyzes any existing data and concludes that the benefits
13 of such vaccine outweigh the risks.

14 (2) The Department of Health shall conduct a study and make
15 recommendations on the benefits and risks of the administration of
16 COVID-19 mRNA vaccinations. Such analysis shall include, but not
17 be limited to, self-controlled case series which shall be
18 completed within one (1) year of the effective date of this act.



19 The use of such vaccine may only continue after the department
20 determines that the administration of the COVID-19 mRNA
21 vaccinations are safe.

22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
23 and after its passage.
