REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MR. PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1780: Appropriation; Forestry Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be	
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General	
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance	
8	of the State Forestry Commission for the fiscal year beginning

11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be	
12	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in	
13	the State Treasury to the credit of the State Forestry Commission	
14	which is comprised of special source funds collected by or	
15	otherwise available to the commission, for the support and	
16	maintenance of the commission for the fiscal year beginning	
17	July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025\$ 14,220,094.00.	

18 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 19 this act, the following positions are authorized:

20 AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:

21 Permanent: 326

22 Time-Limited: 7

23 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal 24 Services for Fiscal Year 2026 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2025 funds 25 26 appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are 27 added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2025 budget by the Mississippi 28 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's 29 personal services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board 30 shall publish. The agency's personal services appropriation may consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year 31 32 2025 that may be utilized to fill vacant Fiscal Year 2024 33 headcount. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that 34 the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount and not for promotions, title changes, in-range salary adjustments 35 36 or any other mechanism for increasing salaries for current 37 employees. It is the Legislature's intention that no employee 38 salary falls below the minimum salary established by the 39 Mississippi State Personnel Board.

43 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2025 do 44 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If 45 the agency's Fiscal Year 2025 projected cost exceeds the 46 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the 47 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be 48 essential for the agency.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 49 50 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or 51 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 52 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 53 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 54 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 55 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 56 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 57 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

66 With the funds appropriated herein, it shall be the agency's 67 responsibility to ensure that no employee in a job classification

71 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 72 State Forestry Commission shall maintain complete accounting and 73 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 74 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 75 76 2024. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 77 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be submitted to 78 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 79 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 80 during the Fiscal Year 2025 budget request process.

81 SECTION 5. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 82 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 83 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 84 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 85 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 86 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 87 performance measures provided below:

105 A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets 106 set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the 107 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget 108 Committee for Fiscal Year 2026.

SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, it is the intention of the Legislature that Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be transferred to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce for the Beaver Control or Eradication Program during the Fiscal Year 2025.

114 **SECTION 7.** Any funds in the Salary, Wages and Fringe 115 Benefits major object of expenditure may be used to purchase 116 accumulated compensatory time within the funds available. 117 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that 118 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 119 120 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 121 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 122 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 123 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 124 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

132 **SECTION 10.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 133 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 134 135 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 136 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 137 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 138 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from 139 and after July 1, 2024.
