REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MR. PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1788: Appropriation; Public Utilities Staff.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the
8	expenses of the Public Utilities Staff for the fiscal year
9	beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025
10	\$ 2,666,616.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in
13	the State Treasury to the credit of the Public Utilities Staff
14	which is comprised of special source funds for the purpose of
15	defraying the expenses of the agency for the Atlas Project for the
16	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025
17	\$ 80,000.00.

18 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 19 this act, the following positions are authorized:

20 AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:

21 Permanent: 27

22 Time-Limited: 0

23 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 24 responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal Services for Fiscal Year 2026 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2025 funds 25 26 appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are 27 added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2025 budget by the Mississippi 28 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's 29 personal services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board 30 shall publish. The agency's personal services appropriation may consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year 31 32 2025 that may be utilized to fill vacant Fiscal Year 2024 33 headcount. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that 34 the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount and not for promotions, title changes, in-range salary adjustments 35 36 or any other mechanism for increasing salaries for current 37 employees. It is the Legislature's intention that no employee 38 salary falls below the minimum salary established by the 39 Mississippi State Personnel Board.

Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and
publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current
employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to
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43 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2025 do 44 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If 45 the agency's Fiscal Year 2025 projected cost exceeds the 46 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the 47 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be 48 essential for the agency.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 49 50 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or 51 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 52 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 53 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 54 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 55 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 56 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 57 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

66 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Eighty 67 Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00), or so much thereof as may be

24/HR13/HB1788CR.J *HR13/OHB1788CR.J* (H)A1;AP (S)AP PAGE 3 (LP/DW) 68 necessary, shall be derived out of any money in the State Treasury 69 to the credit of the Project Atlas Fund, as created in House Bill 70 1, 2nd Extraordinary Session of 2024, and allocated in a manner as 71 determined by the Treasurer's Office. These funds are provided 72 for expediting services needed for Project Atlas.

73 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 74 Public Utilities Staff shall maintain complete accounting and 75 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 76 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 77 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 78 2024. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 79 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be submitted to 80 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 81 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 82 during the Fiscal Year 2025 budget request process.

83 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that 84 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 85 86 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 87 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 88 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 89 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 90 made without competitive bids.

91 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 92 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with

98 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 99 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 100 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 101 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 102 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 103 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 104 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from

105 and after July 1, 2024.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM GENERAL FUNDS IN THE 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 PUBLIC UTILITIES STAFF FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025.
