REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MR. PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1825: Appropriation; Library Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1c.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance
8	of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying out the
9	provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the
10	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025

20	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21	this act, the following positions are authorized:

24	Time-Limited: 1
25	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
26	responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal
27	Services for Fiscal Year 2026 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2025 funds
28	appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
29	added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2025 budget by the Mississippi
30	Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's
31	personal services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board
32	shall publish. The agency's personal services appropriation may
33	consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year
34	2025 that may be utilized to fill vacant Fiscal Year 2024
35	headcount. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that
36	the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount
37	and not for promotions, title changes, in-range salary adjustments
38	or any other mechanism for increasing salaries for current
39	employees. It is the Legislature's intention that no employee
40	salary falls below the minimum salary established by the
41	Mississippi State Personnel Board.
42	Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and
43	publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current

- 44 employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to
- 45 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2025 do
- 46 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If
- 47 the agency's Fiscal Year 2025 projected cost exceeds the
- 48 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the
- 49 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be
- 50 essential for the agency.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 52 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or
- 53 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 54 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 55 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 56 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 57 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 58 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 59 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 61 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for
- 62 salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are
- 63 withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 65 violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A
- 66 relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 67 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.



- 68 **SECTION 4.** Funds to be distributed to eligible public
- 69 library systems under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall
- 70 be paid quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December
- 71 31, March 31 and June 30.
- 72 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 73 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting
- 74 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 75 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 76 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 77 2024. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 78 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be submitted to
- 79 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 80 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 81 during the Fiscal Year 2025 budget request process.
- 82 **SECTION 6.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 83 Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred
- 84 Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the
- 85 Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75
- 86 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 87 **SECTION 7.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 88 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
- 89 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
- 90 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
- 91 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,

- A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets

 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget
- 120 Committee for Fiscal Year 2026.
- 121 **SECTION 8.** It is the intention of the Legislature that no
- 122 less than One Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 123 (\$1,350,000.00) shall be expended for the Magnolia Database.
- 124 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Three
- 125 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) or so much thereof as
- 126 may be necessary, is derived from the Education Enhancement Fund
- 127 pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of
- 128 1972, for MAGNOLIA.
- 129 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds appropriated herein, Four Million
- 130 Five Hundred Eighty-four Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-nine
- 131 Dollars (\$4,584,389.00) is provided for the cost of health
- insurance for all full-time library staff members in each public
- 133 library in Mississippi.
- 134 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 135 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 136 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 137 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 138 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 139 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 140 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 141 made without competitive bids.



142	SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
143	funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
144	Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
145	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
146	appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
147	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
148	actions contrary to this provision.

SECTION 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2024.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
