REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MR. PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1951: Appropriation; Health, Department of, for funding the ARPA Rural Water Associations Infrastructure Grant Program.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
7	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Coronavirus
8	State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the
9	State Department of Health for the purpose of funding the ARPA

In addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated 31 32 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit 33 Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal 34 35 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient 36 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit 37 requirements.

38 SECTION 3. (1) As a condition of receiving and expending 39 the funds appropriated to the department under this act, the 40 department shall certify to the Department of Finance and 41 Administration that each expenditure of the funds appropriated to the department under this act complies with the quidelines, 42 43 guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the 44 24/HR13/HB1951CR.J (H)A4 (S)AP

47 If the Office of Inspector General of the United States (2)48 Department of the Treasury or the Office of Inspector General of 49 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies 50 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by 51 ARPA (a) determines that the department or recipient has expended 52 or otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the department 53 under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the 54 quidelines, quidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 55 may be amended from time-to-time, of the United States Department 56 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus 57 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA and (b) the State 58 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any 59 of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined 60 were expended or otherwise used improperly by the department or 61 recipient, then the department or recipient that expended or otherwise used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the 62 63 amount of those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to 64 the federal government.

65 SECTION 4. As a condition of receiving the funds 66 appropriated herein, the State Department of Health shall award 67 these funds to eligible entities that have not previously received 68 funding in prior rounds. 69 SECTION 5. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid 70 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State 71 Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants 72 issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer 73 shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the 74 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 75 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 76 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
