REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2652: Wild turkey stamps; require for wild turkey hunters 16 years of age or older.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 14 **SECTION 1.** (1) For the purposes of this section, the
- 15 following words and phrases shall have the meanings ascribed
- 16 herein unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 17 (a) "Wild turkey" means the game bird Meleagris
- 18 gallopavo.
- 19 (b) "Stamp" means the state wild turkey stamp, either
- 20 in its physical or electronic form, furnished by the commission.
- 21 A stamp is a specialized permit required for hunting wild turkeys,
- 22 with proceeds directly dispersed into the conservation,
- 23 management, protection or scientific research of wild turkeys.
- (c) "Harvest tag" means the electronic tool used to
- 25 serve as an inventory of the annual bag limit allotted to
- 26 individual wild turkey hunters. Harvest tags are invalidated upon
- 27 the harvest of a wild turkey.

- 28 (d) "Nongovernmental entity" means a nonprofit
- 29 organization primarily concerned with the protection and
- 30 conservation of land and natural resources, as evidenced by its
- 31 organizational documents.
- 32 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person sixteen (16) years
- 33 of age or older to hunt or take wild turkeys during any open wild
- 34 turkey season in the State of Mississippi without first having
- 35 procured a stamp. The electronic stamp on file with the
- 36 commission shall serve as proof of procurement.
- 37 (3) The fee to resident hunters for each stamp shall be Ten
- 38 Dollars (\$10.00). The fee to nonresident hunters for each stamp
- 39 shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). The holder of a resident
- 40 or nonresident lifetime sportsman license shall be exempt from
- 41 paying the fee. Each stamp shall be valid through the final day
- 42 of the spring wild turkey season following its purchase. After
- 43 its expiration, another stamp must be procured in order to hunt or
- 44 take wild turkeys in a future open wild turkey season.
- 45 (4) The commission may make the procurement of harvest tags
- 46 dependent upon the purchase of a stamp.
- 47 (5) The commission shall determine the form of the stamp.
- 48 The commission shall furnish physical stamps to bonded agents for
- 49 issuance or sale in the same manner as other types of licenses or
- 50 shall cause the electronic stamp to accrue to the purchaser's
- 51 benefit when purchased from an automated point-of-sale source.

- 52 (6) Any person violating any of the provisions of this
- 53 section shall be quilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction,
- 54 shall be fined not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more
- 55 than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) as prescribed in Section
- 56 49-7-101.
- 57 (7) All revenue from the proceeds of stamps shall be
- 58 deposited into the Fisheries and Wildlife Fund created in Section
- 59 49-5-21 and shall be used and expended only for the following
- 60 objectives:
- 61 (a) Paying administrative or processing costs
- 62 associated with an electronic harvest tag program, or any other
- 63 program governing or regulating the harvest of wild turkeys;
- (b) Restoring, enhancing or protecting wild turkey
- 65 populations or their habitats on public or private lands in
- 66 Mississippi as prescribed by the department;
- 67 (c) Funding scientific research, as conducted by
- 68 qualified professionals, into the ecology or management of wild
- 69 turkeys, their habitats or their predators; and
- 70 (d) Increasing access to publicly available turkey
- 71 hunting opportunities.
- 72 (8) Proceeds from stamps may be used as matching funds or
- 73 fiscal leverage to secure grants or other financial awards which
- 74 are deemed to align with the objectives in subsection (7) of this
- 75 section. No such proceeds shall be expended for administrative
- 76 salaries.

- 77 The commission may enter into agreements with other
- 78 state, federal or nongovernmental entities to execute the
- 79 objectives in subsection (7) of this section.
- 80 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a new
- 81 section in Title 49, Chapter 7, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 82 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- and after July 1, 2024. 83

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL PERSONS 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER TO 2 PROCURE A WILD TURKEY STAMP BEFORE HUNTING WILD TURKEYS IN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO ESTABLISH THE FEE FOR RESIDENT AND NONRESIDENT HUNTERS, AND TO EXEMPT HOLDERS OF A LIFETIME SPORTSMAN 5 LICENSE FROM THE FEE; TO PROVIDE FOR THE FURNISHING OF THE STAMP; TO SET PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; TO PROVIDE THAT ALL REVENUE FROM THE PROCEEDS OF STAMPS SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE FISHERIES AND WILDLIFE FUND, AND TO PROVIDE THE OBJECTIVES FOR WHICH SUCH 9 REVENUE MAY BE USED AND EXPENDED; TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION ON 10 WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER 11 STATE, FEDERAL OR NONGOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES TO EXECUTE SUCH 12 OBJECTIVES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
