REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2801: Distinctive motor vehicle license tag; authorize for supporters of Clarkdale High School in Lauderdale County.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

73 SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 74 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 75 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 76 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 77 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 78 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 79 80 vehicle registered in his name, which shall be of such color and 81 design as the department, with the advice of American Family 82 Association, Inc., may prescribe.
