REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3008: Appropriation; IHL - Alcorn State - Agricultural programs.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and 8 maintenance of the Alcorn State University Agricultural Research, 9 Extension, and Land-Grant Programs for the fiscal year beginning 10 July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025......\$ 7,851,172.00.

SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available, for the support and maintenance of the Alcorn State University Agricultural Research, Extension, and Land-Grant Programs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025..... 335,000.00.

Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this 19 act, Three Hundred Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$335,000.00) shall be derived from funds in the Education Enhancement Fund 20 deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi 21 22 Code of 1972, and allocated in a matter as determined by the 23 Treasurer's Office. These funds are provided for the following: 24 Agency Operations.....\$ 170,000.00. (a) 25 Poultry Sciences Academic Research (b) 26 Center.....\$ 165,000.00.

27 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 28 act, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) is provided for 29 the Poultry Sciences Academic Research Center.

30 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 31 act, Seven Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$715,000.00) is 32 provided for Agricultural Research and Extension including poultry 33 science, animal science, and environmental science programs.

34 SECTION 6. No general funds authorized to be expended herein 35 shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds 36 which are being used for salaries which are withdrawn and no 37 longer available.

38 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 39 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be submitted to 40 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 41 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 42 during the Fiscal Year 2025 budget request process.

It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 44 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 45 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 46 47 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 48 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 49 50 made without competitive bids.

51 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 52 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 53 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 54 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 55 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 56 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 57 actions contrary to this provision.

58 **SECTION 10.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 59 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 60 61 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 62 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 63 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 64 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from 65 and after July 1, 2024.
