## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3163: Appropriation; additional to DFA-Administration, ARPA funds.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 necessary, is appropriated out of any money not otherwise 9 appropriated to the credit of the Coronavirus State Fiscal 10 Recovery Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by the 11 Treasurer's Office, to the Department of Finance and 12 Administration for the purpose of defraying administrative and reporting expenses for the period beginning on passage, and ending 13 14 June 30, 2025.....\$ 15,000,000.00. This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying 15 16 eligible administration and reporting expenses related to the 17 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Funds incurred on or after March

3, 2021, through the final expenditure date as determined by the

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- 20 **SECTION 2.** None of the funds appropriated under this act
- 21 shall be used to pay employee premium payments.
- 22 **SECTION 3.** (1) As used in this section and Section 4 of
- 23 this act, the term "department" means the Department of Finance
- 24 and Administration.
- 25 (2) The department shall not disburse any funds appropriated
- 26 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an
- 27 individualized determination that the expenditure sought is, in
- 28 the department's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures
- 29 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as
- 30 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
- 31 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules,
- 32 regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or
- 33 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of
- 34 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not
- 35 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in
- 36 question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds,
- 37 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal
- 38 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. In
- 39 addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated
- 40 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit
- 41 Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the
- 42 Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal
- 43 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding subrecipient

- 44 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit 45 requirements.
- 46 As a condition of receiving and expending (1)47 the funds appropriated to the department under this act, the 48 department shall certify that each expenditure of the funds 49 appropriated to the department under this act complies with the 50 guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 51 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department 52 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus 53 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA.
- 54 (2) If the Office of Inspector General of the United States Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of 55 56 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies 57 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by 58 ARPA (a) determines that the department or recipient has expended 59 or otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the department 60 under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 61 62 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department 63 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus 64 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA; and (b) the State 65 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined 66 67 were expended or otherwise used improperly by the department or recipient, then the department or recipient that expended or 68

SECTION 5. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State
Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants
issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer
shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
