HOUSE BILL NO. 724 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-13-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO CREATE A CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR SOMEONE WHO ASSISTS AN ELECTOR 3 WITH CASTING A BALLOT, BUT WILLFULLY FAILS TO TURN IN THE BALLOT WITH THE INTENT OF THE BALLOT NOT BEING CAST OR COUNTED IN THE 4 5 ELECTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 97-13-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 9 97-13-13. (1) If any person shall take or remove any ballot 10 from a voting place before the close of the polls, he or she shall, on conviction, be imprisoned in the county jail not more 11 12 than one (1) year, or be fined not more than One Thousand Dollars 13 (\$1,000.00), or both. 14 (2) If any person assisting an elector with voting in 15 accordance with Section 23-15-907 willfully fails to transmit the 16 ballot that was mailed to the elector with the intent of the 17 ballot not being cast and counted in the election, the person shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be 18 19 imprisoned in the county jail for not more than one (1) year, and

20 subject to a fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars
