## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 10

- A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING THE JACKSON STATE
  UNIVERSITY "TIGERS" FOOTBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH T.C. TAYLOR UPON
- 3 WINNING THE 2024 SOUTHWESTERN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE (SWAC)
- 4 CHAMPIONSHIP AND THE 2024 CELEBRATION BOWL, MAKING THEM THE 2024
- 5 HBCU NATIONAL CHAMPIONS.
- 6 WHEREAS, the Jackson State University "Tigers" Football Team,
- 7 led by Coach T.C. Taylor, reigned supreme during the 2024 season,
- 8 winning the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) Championship
- 9 and the 2024 HBCU National Championship; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Tigers, who had a superior season that was
- 11 driven by more than just the yearning to succeed, intensely
- 12 amplified all of their hard work, motivation and audacity, which
- 13 were so apparent all through the season, for their historic
- 14 championship series runs; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Zy McDonald came off the bench late in the first
- 16 half, sparking a rally from Jackson State and leading the Tigers
- 17 to a 41-13 victory over Southern in the 2024 Pepsi SWAC

- 18 Championship Game presented by GM at Mississippi Veterans Memorial
- 19 Stadium; and

20	WHEREAS, the SWAC championship is the third in four years for
21	Jackson State (11-2), winners of nine straight games, and the
22	first for head coach and Jackson State alum, T.C. Taylor; and
23	WHEREAS, McDonald was named the Offensive MVP after leading a
24	touchdown drive to tie the game late in the first half, and he
25	also orchestrated five second-half scoring drives and finished
26	with 95 yards rushing on eight carries and a touchdown; and
27	WHEREAS, additionally, Zy McDonald also threw for 75 yards on
28	6-of-11 with a touchdown, and Irv Mulligan added 116 yards on 23
29	carries with a touchdown, while Travis Terrell, Jr., added 47
30	yards rushing and a touchdown for the Tigers who finished with 275
31	yards, and Jameel Gardner, Jr., had four receptions for 71 yards;
32	and
33	WHEREAS, defensively, during the SWAC Championship, Robert
34	McDaniel intercepted two passes including one to put an
35	exclamation on the game late, and was named Defensive MVP, and
36	Shamar Hawkins finished with eight tackles, a sack, and a tackle
37	for loss, while Ashton Taylor finished with seven tackles and a
38	sack, and Joshua Nobles finished with five tackles with a sack and
39	a forced fumble; and
40	WHEREAS, after claiming victory at the SWAC Championship, the
41	Tigers traveled to Atlanta, Georgia, for the Cricket Celebration
42	Bowl, where their dominance and perseverance continued; and
43	WHEREAS, Jackson State jumped out to a three-touchdown lead
44	early in the fourth quarter before South Carolina State (9-3) was

- 45 able to get on the board, and they put the game away with the
- 46 second touchdown reception from Joanes Fortilien with 4:47 to
- 47 play; and
- 48 WHEREAS, the Tigers used a 19-play, 78-yard drive to close
- 49 the first quarter and open the second quarter culminating with a
- 50 four-yard pass from Jacobian Morgan to Fortilien in the back of
- 51 the end zone for a 7-0 lead, and they added to the lead with a
- 52 pair of Irv Mulligan rushing touchdowns to take a 21-0 lead with
- 53 14:48 to play in the game; and
- 54 WHEREAS, Jackson State outgained South Carolina State 385-178
- on the night in total yards including a 122-yard difference in
- 56 rushing, and the Tigers finished the night with 152 yards to just
- 57 30 for South Carolina State with Irv Mulligan finishing with 71
- 58 yards on 25 carries, Emari Matthews finished with 55 yards on 11
- 59 carries, and Morgan 24 yards on 10 carries; and
- 60 WHEREAS, as the clock started to wind down late in the fourth
- 61 quarter and emotions began to show on the Jackson State sideline,
- 62 the Tigers lined up in victory formation to seal a 28-7 victory in
- 63 the Cricket Celebration Bowl over South Carolina State to capture
- 64 the 2024 HBCU National Championship with its tenth consecutive
- 65 victory; and
- 66 WHEREAS, Morgan finished the day 15-of-21 for 233 yards with
- 67 Fortilien leading the way with six receptions and 43 yards, and
- 68 Isaiah Spencer finished with 123 yards on three receptions and
- 69 Ja'Naylon Dupree had 31 yards on three receptions; and

71 and one interception, and Cameron Smith finished with five, and 72 the Tigers ended the night with three sacks and five tackles for 73 loss against South Carolina State; and 74 WHEREAS, the Tigers, who played with nothing but heart and 75 soul all season, have a very talented and distinguished roster, 76 and each player made a substantial contribution that led to one of 77 the most historic seasons in the history of the Tigers football 78 program; and 79 WHEREAS, the HBCU National Championship is the fourth in 80 school history, the first since 1996, and the first for second-year head coach, T.C. Taylor; and 81 82 WHEREAS, Head Coach Taylor has superbly coached and tremendously inspired the Tigers and broadened their knowledge of 83 the game while refining their skills in execution, and he 84 85 continues to build upon the legacy of superior play and true 86 sportsmanship forged by the tenacious and undaunted spirit of each 87 team member; and 88 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to 89 recognize and commend outstanding Mississippi student-athletes, 90 especially those such as the Jackson State University "Tigers" 91 Football Team, whose hard work and perseverance bring honor to their school, their community and the State of Mississippi: 92

WHEREAS, on defense, Shamar Hawkins finished with six tackles
